

Academic Eligibility Requirements Aptos High School Athletic Department

- 1. To be academically eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics at Aptos High School, all student-athletes must:
 - a. be passing at least 25 semester units, or 12.5 quarter units,
 - b. be achieving a minimum overall GPA of 2.00,
 - c. be passing 5 classes, and
 - d. be making minimum progress towards graduation. (PVUSD Bylaws sec. 5312)
- Quarter grades are used at the quarter mark to determine eligibility, and semester grades at the semester mark. Summer school grades may be used only to supplement or remediate spring semester grades to determine fall eligibility. (PVUSD Bylaws sec. 5312, CIF Bylaws sec. 207)
- 3. College classes used for athletic eligibility must be approved by an administrator or counselor prior to the season of participation. All college classes must be worth at least 1.5 college units or more.
- 4. There is no appeal process provided under PVUSD by-laws for academic ineligibility.
- 5. Academic eligibility will be posted twenty-four (24) hours after the grade book is closed (i.e., 24 hours after the deadline for teachers to enter their grades). No athlete will be declared eligible or ineligible prior to that deadline.
- 6. Even seniors, who are on track to graduate and have a surplus of units, must take and pass 5 classes (25 semester units) every grading period to be eligible. (PVUSD Bylaw sec. 5312)
- Residential Eligibility Any athlete who did not enter Aptos High School in the fall semester
 of his/her ninth grade year needs to see the Athletic Director (i.e., all transfer students).
 This includes all foreign exchange students. (CIF Bylaws sec. 211, 212, 214-222)
