Anyone who has experienced or answered YES to any of the questions above should be excluded from entering the facility or participating in the activity on campus until:

1. 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication AND 10 days since symptoms first appeared AND symptoms have improved
2. 14 days after last close contact with diagnosed case of COVID-19

Anyone who is free of all symptoms above and has answered NO to all questions will be able to enter the facility and participate in activities with the following restrictions:

1. Wash/sanitize hands throughout their time in the building or during the activity
2. Do not shake hands with, touch or hug anyone
3. Practice social/physical distancing, keeping at last 6 feet spacing if possible. **Masks must be worn at all times.**
