

TEAM EXPECTATIONS 2014

1. Practices and games are mandatory for all players

- a. Players who miss school on a day that practice is scheduled are not permitted to practice on that day.
- b. Players who miss school on a day that a game is scheduled are not permitted to play in that game.
- c. Players who are late/ leave early from practice will be permitted to play, but not start, in the next game.
- d. Players who miss a practice will not be permitted to participate in the next game.
- e. Players who are late on day that a game is scheduled will not be permitted to start in that game but will be permitted to play provided that they are in school for at least half of their scheduled day.
- f. **EXCEPTIONS**: School related activity or excused absence that is approved by the **head coach** 48 hours prior
- 2. The regular lacrosse season starts on 3/1 and ends approximately 5/15. We will have practices and play games over spring break. All players are required to attend.
- 3. Practices will be held everyday but Sunday for approx. 2 hours. A practice schedule will be provided.
- 4. Players are responsible for arranging rides to and from practice.
- 5. No cell phone usage is permitted during practice or games.
- 6. You are expected to be dressed and ready before practice. Lateness or unexcused absence will result in disciplinary action as deemed appropriate by the coaching staff.
- 7. Players participating in a winter sport are not allowed to attend practice until their season ends. Players will be required to attend tryouts/practice the next day after winter season ends.
- 8. Students, while participating on a school team, are permitted to participate on sports teams outside of school during the high school sport's season, as long as the outside participation does not conflict with practice or contests
- 9. Uniforms distributed to players are to be kept clean and will be returned at the end of the season.
- 10. The first form of communication is from the player \rightarrow coach, not the parent \rightarrow coach.
 - a. Issues NOT appropriate for PARENTS to discuss with a coach (*directly from MPSSAA Handbook*)
 - i. Playing time
 - ii. Team strategy
 - iii. Play calling
 - iv. Other student-athletes
- 11. <u>Players and Parents</u>: Respect coaches and their decisions. Second guessing their work does not provide a positive atmosphere for the player, coach and parents.
