Motion was made by Tammi Rhoads to give the softball team \$ 1750.00 to purchase 2 pitching machines; motion was seconded by Stacy Sefton; all voted in favor.

A request was made for a new pricing board for the new concession. Rachelle Shendow is on it – she is making new ones. Thank you Rachelle!

The problem with the electrical outlets in the new concession is being addressed by Bobby Levi.
