## 2023 Individual Wrestling Finals

Below is tentative information as it pertains to the **2023 Individual Wrestling Finals** hosted at **Ford Field (March 3 & 4, 2023)**.

### NEW!!!

The following items (#1-#10) will take place on **THURSDAY March 2, 2023 between 4:30PM & 6:30PM at Birmingham Groves H.S.**

- Birmingham Groves: 20500 W 13 Mile Rd / Beverly Hills, MI 48025. (*maps as they pertain to Groves H.S. are below*)

Schools may arrive during this window at any time but must enter with all participants from your school together. It is recommended that you plan ahead as the below items will NOT be delayed due to weather, traffic or other unforeseen issues or circumstances that may delay arrival. We plan to take care of the “non-wrestling” items on Thursday, so that when participants arrive at Ford Field on Friday, coaches and wrestlers will only have to focus on WRESTLING.

1. **WAIVERS:** ALL wrestlers and coaches (that have completed the online rules meeting) **MUST** have correctly completed the Ford Field online waiver. All waivers **MUST** be completed by **Wednesday March 1, 2023 (noon)**. If you have not completed the waiver for your coaching staff and wrestlers, you will NOT receive your credentials and NOT be allowed to be inspected or weighed in. [WAIVER LINK](#)
2. **CHECK-IN/CREDENTIALS:** Will take place **Thursday** (at Groves H.S. 4:30PM – 6:30PM).  
Waivers must be completed by **Wed 3-1-23 (noon)** to be issued credentials and allowed to be inspected / weighed-in.  
**INSPECTION:** Will take place **Thursday** (at Groves H.S. 4:30PM – 6:30PM).
3. **WEIGH-INS:** **Only ONE (1) weigh-in will take place on Thursday March 2, 2023 (at Groves H.S. 4:30PM – 6:30PM).**
  - **After weigh-in,** the following items are available for coaches and or wrestlers:
4. **BRACKET CORRECTIONS:** After weigh-in, Dan Riggs will be available for any corrections to the Finals brackets.
5. **OFFICIALS RECRUITMENT:** Information will be available for seniors that may be interested in officiating in the future.
6. **CREDENTIAL LAMINATE:** A station will be set up for those wishing to laminate their credential. **\$3.00** for this service.
7. **MWA LETTER/INFO:** A station will be set up for coaches to pick up information from the MI Wrestling Coaches Association.
8. **PROGRAM:** A QR code will be posted in the hallway at Groves for coaches and wrestlers to access the Finals program.
9. **VENDORS:** Vendors that are MHSAA partners may be available.

### DETROIT: FORD FIELD FRIDAY 3-3-23 & SATURDAY 3-4-23

- **ARRIVAL:** It is recommended that you plan ahead and **ARRIVE EARLY**. The event will NOT be delayed due to weather, traffic or other unforeseen issues or circumstances that may delay arrival.
- **AWARDS:** **ALL AWARDS WILL BE CONDUCTED AFTER ALL FINALS MATCHES HAVE BEEN COMPLETED.**
- **BACK PACKS:** **Wrestlers will NOT be allowed to bring back packs down to the stadium floor or mats.** Credentialed coaches and wrestlers MAY bring a backpack with their gear into Ford Field, but the bag MAY NOT be taken down to the field.
- **COACHES AREA:** The Michigan Wrestling Coaches Association (MWA) will sponsor a “coaches’ area” on the concourse where coaches will have access to drinks as well as other MWA information.
- **COACH CREDENTIALS:** Coaches of qualifying wrestlers (boys and girls combined) will be supplied with a minimum of two (2) coaches’ passes, and a maximum of six (6) coaches passes depending on the number of qualifiers.

- **Make sure ANY potential coach utilized at the Finals, has completed the MHSAA “in-person” or “online” wrestling rules meeting, and that it is verified and confirmed with your AD!**

- **Be sure that these individuals have been vetted by your school administration (background check, etc.), and that these individuals will NOT cause issues with “out-of-season” coaching limitations.**
- **Schools that misuse and or share coaching credentials will lose the pass for the remainder of the event, and the school may also lose coaches passes to future events.**
- **COACHES MEETING:** The coaches meeting is a **VIDEO** that coaches may login and watch. A link will be sent shortly for coaches to access.
- **COACH/WRESTLER ENTRY:** Wrestlers and coaches will enter through **Gate “A” or “G”**.
  - Spouses, parents or others that are entering with a digital ticket, **MUST** wait to enter through Gate “A” or Gate “G” at the normally allowed time for spectators (GA: general admission).
  - Reminder: Wrestlers and coaches will have “In & Out” access during the event at Ford Field.
- **CONCESSIONS:** A few of the concession stands now offer healthier choices for competing athletes. Locations will be shared via the “Coaches Meeting” video.
- **DROP OFF:** If coaches, or participants are running late, we will have a designated area for “drop off”. (*Please see map*). This is **NOT** required, simply an option if needed. **PLEASE NOTE:** this area is a ONE-WAY street, so it is important to familiarize yourself ahead of time. After dropping off, the driver will need to find a place to park.
- **FLAGS:** Each of the five (5) Divisions will carry a flag during the Marches & display during the Anthems.
- **FOOD:** **PERSONAL FOOD AND DRINKS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED INTO FORD FIELD. PLEASE PLAN ACCORDINGLY!**
- **FORMAT:** The SEMIS will be wrestled FRIDAY evening.
  - All sessions may start **AHEAD** of schedule **EXCEPT** for Rd#1, Rd#5 (SEMIS), Rd #6 and Rd#9 (FINALS).
- **HOTELS:** Hotels are the responsibility of the individual schools.
- **MAPS:** Tentative maps are provided (below) to help coaches, wrestlers and spectators as they travel to the event. We encourage all to become familiar with the area (streets, parking, entrances, etc.) **BEFORE** the event.
- **MARCH:** We will have a “Grand March” (all wrestlers) to begin the event and a “Finals March” (all placers) before the FINALS.
- **MATS:** We will be using five (5) mats per Division (25 mats total). We will use all 5 mats per Division through the tournament, except for the Semis, Place & Finals. (*Tentative layout provided below*)
- **PARKING:** Parking (for a fee) is available. (see tentative map) **AVAILABILITY AND PRICES WILL VARY BY LOCATION.**
- **SECURITY:** Ford Field will be using the magnetometers as participants, coaches and spectators enter Ford Field. Please be prepared and **PATIENT** as we do our best to provide a safe environment for all.
- **SEMIS:** We will run two (2) weight classes at the same time (4 matches). The next weight class (in that Division) would not begin until the previous weight class (in that Division) is complete.
- **SUITES:** Ford Field will **NOT** be offering suites for the Finals.
- **TICKETS:** ALL tickets may be purchased online in advance at <https://www.mhsaa.com/tickets>.
  - Tickets may be purchased on-site using cash or credit card.
- **WARM-UP:** We will tentatively have three (3) mats for use in the “warm-up” area.
- **WATER BOTTLES:** Wrestlers & coaches may bring **EMPTY** and **CLEAR** water bottles into Ford Field. Water jugs will be available to fill water bottles.

We are excited to be back to Ford Field. We will continue to assess EVERY aspect of the event as we look to continuously improve and make this event the **BEST** in the country!

## ADDITIONAL ITEMS

1. **ENTRY:** Only the first four place finishers in each weight class at each Regional Tournament will qualify to the Final Tournament. All Divisions will wrestle a 16-wrestler bracket.
2. **AUTHORITY OF PHYSICIAN AT TOURNAMENT:** If the physician assigned to the tournament decides that a contestant may not start, compete, or continue to wrestle in that tournament, he/she will inform the Tournament Manager. The decision of the medical staff is final.
3. **TOURNAMENT RULES:** The Final Tournament will be conducted in accordance with the National Federation current year *Wrestling Rules Book* except for modifications listed in FINAL NOTES and the current year *WRESTLING MANAGERS MANUAL* and *PARTICIPATING SCHOOL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION (website information, as well)*.
4. **WEIGHT CLASSIFICATIONS – SUBSTITUTIONS:** No substitutions or changes in weight classification will be allowed at the Final Tournament.
5. **CONSOLATION COMPETITION:** It is expected that ALL contestants in the Final Tournament will compete until eliminated. (Exception - illness or injury must be cleared through Tournament Manager and attending Physician *prior* to the match being called to a mat.) All contestants, except for championship finalists, will compete in consolation rounds.
6. **TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP:** None will be determined in the Individual Championship. Voids in the Final Tournament are forfeitures. Wrestlers who fail to compete in the medal rounds will not receive awards unless the tournament manager approves withdrawal for illness or injury as determined by the tournament medical staff.
7. **AWARDS:** Gold - First; Silver - Second; and Bronze medals, Third - Eighth; will be awarded in each weight classification in all Divisions of the Individual Tournament to athletes in school uniform. Head coverings are prohibited. **Wrestlers who appear in anything other than the school warm-up or uniform will not be permitted on the awards stand.**
8. **EXPENSES OF TOURNAMENT:** The Michigan High School Athletic Association will assume the administration expenses of the Final Tournament. Schools will assume all expenses related to their wrestlers, coaches and other team members.
9. **SUPERVISION OF TEAMS:** It is the responsibility of the coach to maintain order and discipline of his/her team members at all times during tournament competition as well as in eating-places, in the tournament city and in hotels or motels. It may be required to undergo a room inspection prior to check out and before the final housing charges are determined. Disorder and unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated. Violators can expect to be removed from the property.
10. **GRIEVANCE COMMITTEE:** See coverage in the *PARTICIPATING SCHOOL TOURNAMENT INFORMATION (PSTI)*.
11. **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:** Information regarding the Final Wrestling Tournament is available online at [MHSAA.com](http://MHSAA.com).
12. **FINAL TOURNAMENT BRACKETS:** Brackets for the Individual Final tournament will be determined by a seeding committee using data generated by TrackWrestling, with the remainder of the bracket built by formula.
13. **HOUSING FOR THE FINAL INDIVIDUAL TOURNAMENT:**
  - A. Coaches who qualify wrestlers to an **Individual** Final Wrestling using the links provided in the [Finals Preferred Hotel](#) form online.
  - B. Be prepared with a credit card to confirm reservations.
  - C. Remaining rooms will be available for **PUBLIC SALE** after 7 p.m. on March 1.

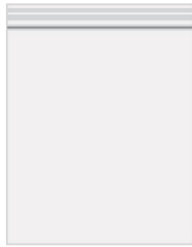

# CLEAR BAG POLICY

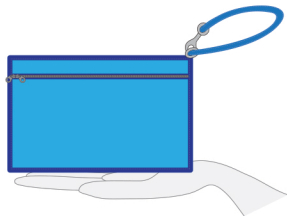
In accordance with Ford Field Security Guidelines, the only bags, packages or containers permitted to be carried by fans as they approach the stadium are the following:



Bag that is clear plastic, vinyl, or PVC and does not exceed 12"x 6"x 12"



One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)



Small clutch bag, camera and binocular cases, not exceeding 4.5"x 6.5", with or without a handle or strap



Exceptions made for medically necessary items after proper inspection.

## PROHIBITED ITEMS DURING DETROIT LIONS GAMES

The items not permitted into Ford Field or when approaching the stadium are in accordance with the NFL Best Practices and are strictly enforced during Detroit Lions home football games and stadium events. Ford Field is not responsible for any items left at the gates or in the trash receptacles. Prohibited items may also be confiscated by staff. Walk-through weapons detection technology is deployed at points of stadium entry. Please follow all signage and direction from security personnel. Ford Field reserves the right to expand or modify the prohibited items at any time.

### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS MAY BE PERMITTED AFTER INSPECTION:

- NFL Policy: Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12"
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar)
- Small clutch bags, camera and binocular cases, not exceeding 4.5" x 6.5", with or without a handle or strap, can be taken into the stadium with one of the clear plastic bag options. For more information, visit [www.nfl.com/allclear](http://www.nfl.com/allclear)
- Medically necessary items including insulin, medication, portable oxygen, small soft pack coolers and breast pumps
- Infant items in a clear bag (bottles, formula) are allowed with a child. Diaper bags are not allowed per the NFL Bag Policy
- Small radios (must be used with an earpiece or headphones)
- Umbrellas, small compact only. Must be placed securely under the seat.
- Handheld posters & signs without poles or sticks. Must not block another guest's view.
- Battery operated clothing or signs if approved after thorough inspection. Loose batteries & wires are not allowed
- Football helmets. Altered helmets, hats or clothing with spikes or weaponry items that can block another person's view are not permitted
- Tablets (iPads, Kindles, etc.) Inappropriate subject matter should not be displayed and must not block another guest's view
- Seat cushions not exceeding 15" x 15" and must not contain arm rests, zippers, pockets, flaps or metal backs



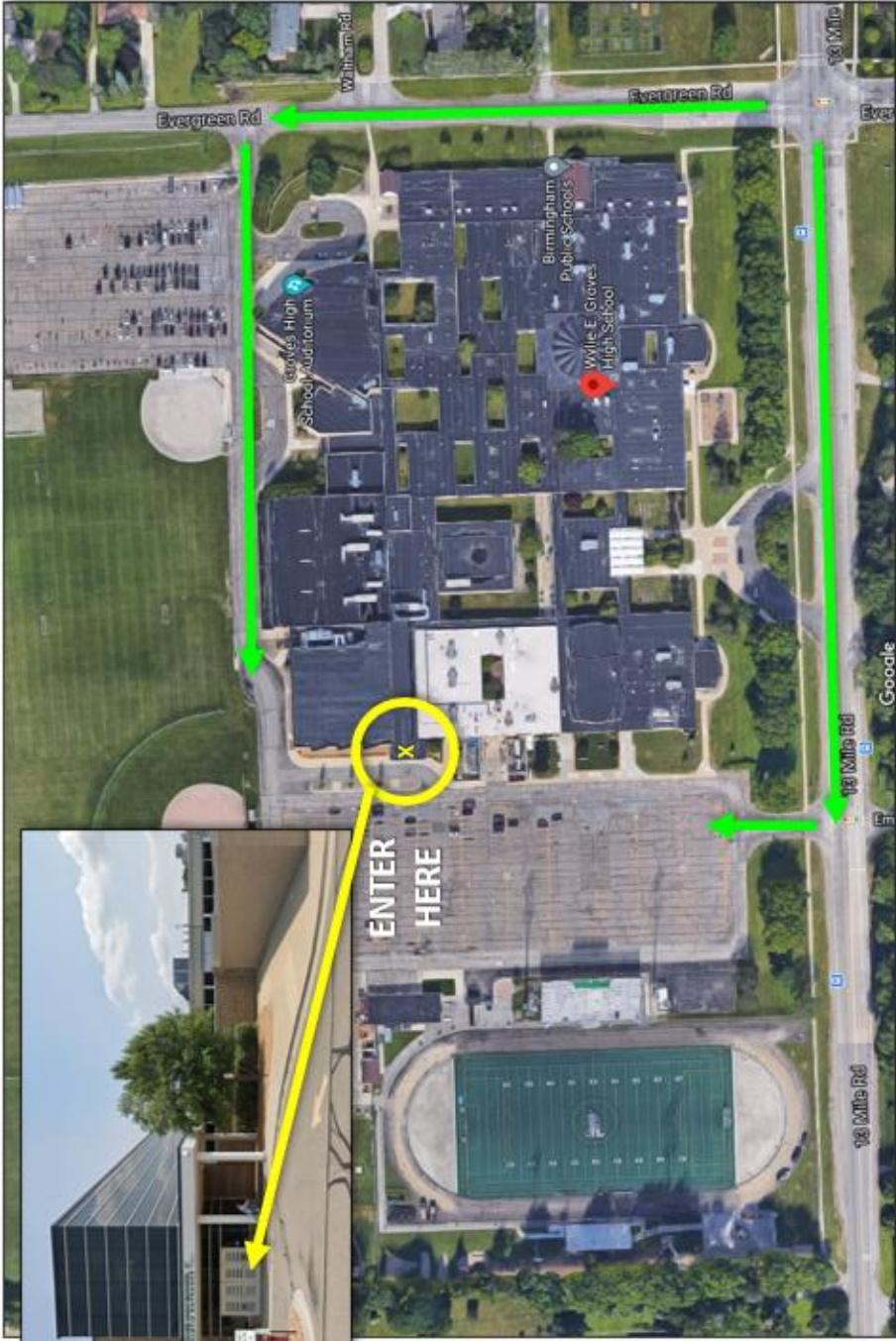
### THE FOLLOWING ITEMS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED (INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO):

- NFL Policy: Purses larger than a clutch bag, coolers, briefcases, backpacks, book bags, diaper bags, fanny packs, cinch bags, grocery and paper bags, duffle bags, computer bags or luggage of any kind.
- Aerosol cans (hairspray, mace, pepper spray, etc.)
- Animals (except certified service animals to aid guests with disabilities)
- Balloons (air or helium)
- Balls (beach balls, footballs, etc.)
- Banners or large flags
- Cameras with lenses longer than five inches or any detachable lens
- Chairs including folding chairs or stools
- Decals, stickers, confetti or glitter
- Drones and/or remote controlled aircraft
- Electronic equipment including laptop computers, video recorders, tripods and wearable video cameras including Go Pros.
- Flashlights
- Fireworks
- Food, beverages or liquids (cans, bottles, water bottles, flasks, cups, boxes, popcorn buckets, etc.)
- Handouts, items or goods intended for unauthorized sale, promotion, exchange or giveaway
- Illegal substances
- Knives, pocket knives, box cutters, scissors, etc.
- Laser pointers
- Marijuana, including medically prescribed, electronic accessories or paraphernalia associated with marijuana or illegal narcotics use.
- Markers (permanent) and/or paint
- Noisemaking devices (bells, horns, kazoos, whistles, etc.)
- Objects that can be used as missiles or projectiles (sticks, poles, bats, clubs, Frisbees, etc.)
- Offensive or profane messages or images on signs and clothing that are distasteful or indecent
- Selfie sticks
- Strollers and infant car seats or carriers
- Umbrellas (large size)
- Weapons including handguns, tasers, chemical sprays, brass knuckles, etc. \*
- Wrapped gifts



\*No weapons are allowed in the stadium. Possession of a firearm or any other weapon is strictly forbidden. Possession of such a weapon will result in immediate confiscation, ejection and possible arrest. Per the NFL, only sworn on duty law enforcement officers acting in their official capacity working as an agent of the Detroit Lions/Ford Field are able to carry a weapon.

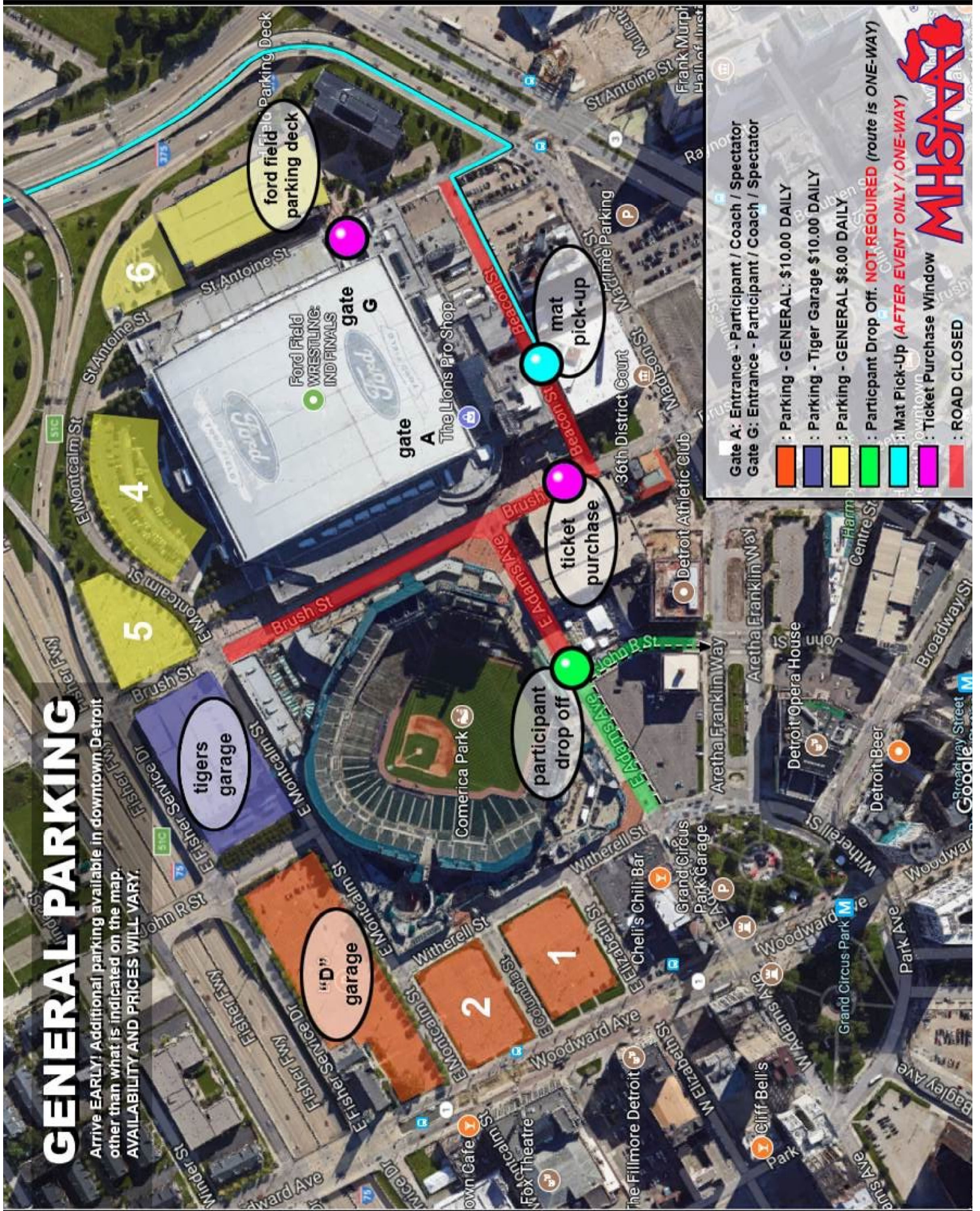

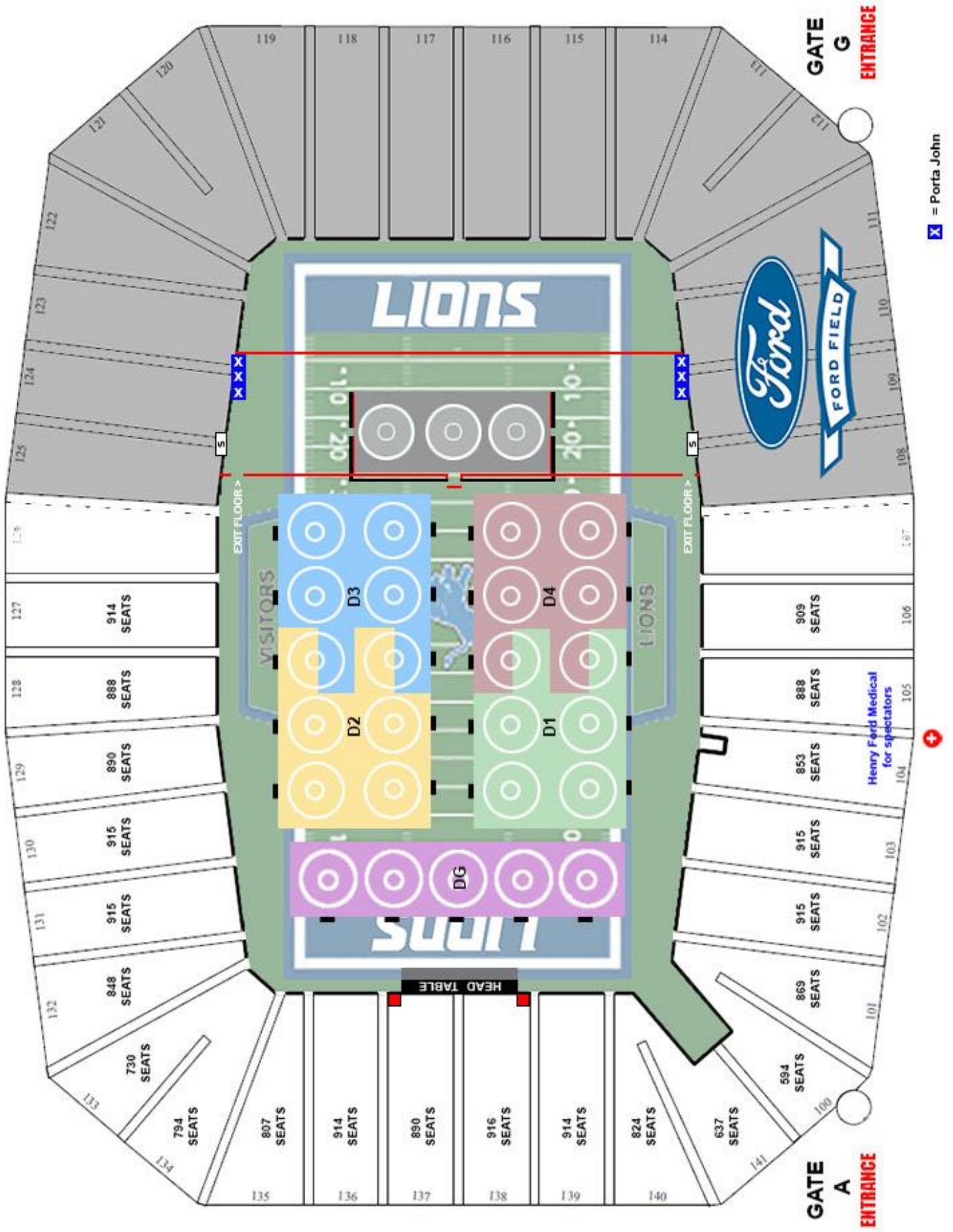

## **MHSAA Individual Wrestling Final Tournament Awards Procedure**

At the MHSAA Wrestling Committee Meeting in January 2002, it was agreed that the Head Coach of the Individual Champion in each weight class of each Division would be permitted to present medals to eight place winners and the Wall Bracket to the champion. Part of the agreement is that the Michigan Wrestling Association President and the MHSAA Assistant Director will craft the protocols, which will be endorsed by both organizations and adhered to by coaches.

### **Coaches Protocol:**

1. The Head Coach only shall be granted the opportunity to present awards. If there are co-coaches one coach will be declared the awards presenter, at check-in.
2. Coaches shall dress in a manner that respects the honor of presenting awards. Slacks and a collared coaching shirt shall be minimum attire. Shorts, tee shirts, jeans and warm-up suits are a few examples of unacceptable attire.
3. **Coaches who receive unsportsmanlike penalties shall be DENIED the opportunity to present awards.**
4. The President of the MWA and an MHSAA designee will be responsible for ensuring that coaches are in compliance with the protocols expected.
5. Coaches will report to the designated area prior to the awards ceremony.
6. In the event the Head Coach is unable to participate in the presentation of awards a member of the MHSAA Tournament Administration or the MHSAA Representative Council will present the awards.

### **Wrestler Protocol:**

1. Wrestlers shall appear on the awards stand in school wrestling apparel. This includes warm-ups or uniforms.
2. Wrestlers shall not be permitted to wear head covers of any type.
3. Unacceptable attire will be removed before an athlete is in position for the ceremony.

### **Commitment**

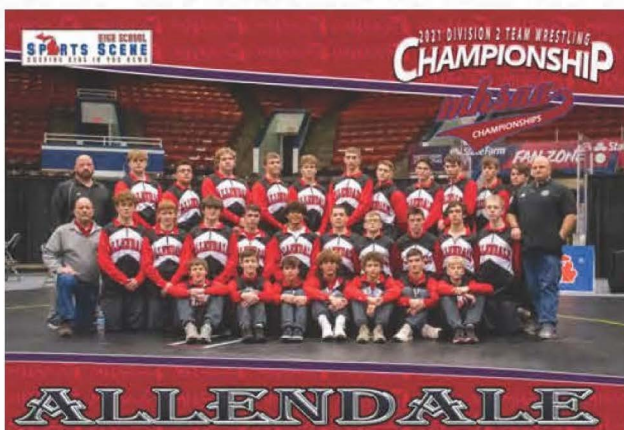

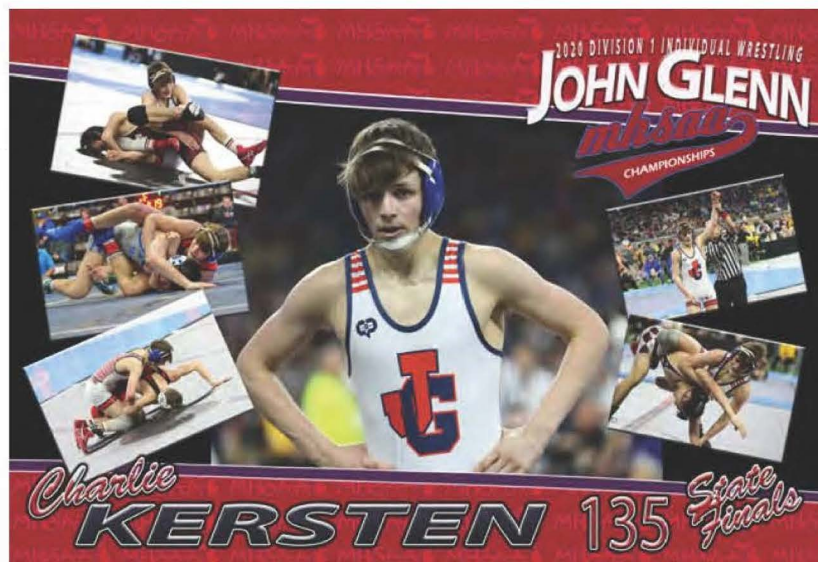
