TRANSPORTATION POLICY

All CBNA Student Athletes are required to take the school provided transportation to all away games.

The Academy is responsible for the transportation of your child to these events.

Transportation Home from Away Games:

Athletes are allowed to leave an away game with another adult or qualified relative. Examples of approved adults:

- Parent
- Grandparent
- Aunt
- Uncle
- Another CBNA Soccer Parent with a signed note naming the appropriate adult to leave with. You can provide a note / letter for the entire year. Be sure to name the student athlete, the parent(s) you authorize your child to drive with, and your signature. This way you do not need to provide a note each game if you have another parent who can help with transportation.
- ALL student athletes NOT taking the bus home must be signed out with the coach prior to leaving the game site for all away matches.
- Any parent signing out an athlete other than their daughter will be required to sign out both athletes at the field before they can leave.

<u>Student athletes are NOT permitted to leave an away game with</u>: 18 - 24 year old sibling, significant other: boyfriend or girlfriend, cousin, student, etc...

The Academy's insurance policy will NOT recognize these individuals in case of an emergency.

(*) If a situation arises where you must have alternative plans for transportation, you must receive prior authorization from the Athletic Director & or Headmaster of CBNA.

Stopping for Food:

<u>We do not stop for dinner after away games,</u> especially on a school night. Student athletes can bring a snack to eat until they are home. Taking an extra hour for food is a hard sell when we already have two hours on the road ahead of us. Getting home at 9 instead of 8 for burgers also impacts student's time spent on homework and studying. We can all eat when we get home.

Northwood Transportation provides us with clean, safe, and professional transportation to our games. It is the expectation of the Academy, the Athletic Department, and the Girls Soccer program that ALL student athletes will conduct themselves in a mature & responsible manner.
