Approve minutes from last meeting – Jen Bonsu-Anane:

The minutes from the September 17, 2018 meeting were approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report – Maureen Burgess:</u>

The FCVA earned \$516.70 from apparel and blanket sales this fall.

The money brought in for the NE Revolution trip is going into the Boys' Soccer account. Funds had been taken out of the account to reimburse the parent who bought the tickets.

Boys' Basketball account received \$125 back from a tournament in Pelham.

Cross-Country bought a silk-screening machine to personalize shirts.

The Fall Fundraiser didn't bring in as much money as last year because there were few fall athletes this year.

Maureen read an email from a concerned parent in the community. The parent was unsure where the FCVA fundraising money goes. She also mentioned that FCVA board members or their children were winning some of the fundraising dollars. There was a discussion about how to address the parents' concerns. <u>Concessions Report – Maureen Burgess/Sandra Faber:</u>

The average per hour earnings from concessions this fall are approximately \$20 per hour.
