

## Jr. High Football Team Rules & Expectations 2022

All team members are expected to abide by the following team rules and expectations. If a team member violates any rule or expectation they will be held accountable on an individual basis. Violation(s) will be dealt with in the following manner by either a Supervised Opportunity Program (SOP), Suspension of Game Participation (Suspension of Playing Time) or Dismissal from the the TEAM. **It's the coaches decision based on the severity and frequency of the violation(s) as to the punishment.**

1. Team members are expected to attend all practices, games, and events by being on time, having a positive attitude, which includes being coachable, and doing the best they can. If a player is not able to attend a practice/game/team event it is the player's responsibility to contact Coach Wetzler by text (814-571-8825 or email ([coach1122@yahoo.com](mailto:coach1122@yahoo.com)) by 2:00 pm on the day of the practice/game/event to notify him of the reason for the absence.

2. Team members are expected to be academically eligible and have clean discipline record.

3. "Playing Time" is earned by quality practices. However we the coaching staff will try, to the best of our ability, to get every Junior High Football TEAM member into our games. Winning is important but at our level we want all of our players to have a positive experience and continue in the program after 9<sup>th</sup> grade.

4. Our final team rule is an all inclusive rule **"Bring No Shame Upon the Family"**. **This rule covers everything that Rules 1 & 2 may have missed.**
