

## **Roundup: Warrior Run boys top Montgomery; Montour girls still unbeaten**

Warrior Run's boys basketball team picked up its first win, 59-46 over Montgomery. Callen Foresman led Warrior Run with 16 points, while Lance Pealer scored 15. Serge Cole led Montgomery with 15 points.

Logan Feltman and Travis Krall scored 13 points apiece as Milton beat Montoursville, 55-36.

Dayton Wood scored 23 points and the North Penn boys basketball team earned its second victory of the season, as the Panthers beat Addison, 54-40, on the road.

Hollidaysburg held Central Mountain to two second-half points, 43-24.

In girls basketball, South Williamsport fell to Southern Columbia, 31-25, after scoring just one point in the third quarter.

St. John Neumann outscored Northumberland Christian 56-11 in the first half en route to a 85-18 win. Meghan Trenholm led Neumann with 20 points and Megan Helminiak and Baylie Gerrity each scored a career-high 16. Emily Sholder added 15 for the Knights.

Montoursville remains undefeated with a 54-33 win over Northwest. Kirsten O'Malley scored a team-high 11 while Marissa Hall and Lexi Marchioni each scored nine for the Warriors.

Akilah McFadden scored 16 with six steals and Emily Conrad added 12 points as Lewisburg defeated Selinsgrove 43-29. Hayley Stanko hauled in eight rebounds for the Green Dragons.

Mansfield scored 21 second-quarter points in pulling away from Towanda, 51-27, as Kaitlyn Garverick scored 21 points.

Maria Morgan had 15 points and 10 rebounds while Tiffany Werts and Hannah Shearer combined for 24 rebounds but Bucktail lost 72-40 at Millville.

Lori Horton had 23 points, 22 rebounds and 8 blocks as Williamson defeated Liberty, 43-36. Kelsey Harer scored 11 for Liberty.

Jersey Shore fell to Bellefonte, 37-36. The Bulldogs couldn't box out at the end of the game, which cost them as Bellefonte reset its offense to score the game-winner.

In men's basketball, five Wildcats scored in double-figures but Penn College fell 98-88 to Central Penn College. Mansfield High School graduate Marquis Delgado scored 13 and dished out nine assists and Montoursville product Ezra Adams added 12 with nine rebounds.

In women's basketball, Penn College picked up its second win of the season with a 79-70 win over Central Penn in women's basketball. Addie Jordan scored 18 points, Danielle Mowery added 14 and seven assists and Charese Bova scored 11 and hauled in 16 rebounds for the Lady Wildcats.
