LEWISBURG—The Lewisburg boys basketball team continued to roll Friday night beating Warrior Run 73-37 in the Heartland Athletic Conference Division II contest.

The win makes the Green Dragons a perfect 10-0, 5-0 HAC-II. The Defenders dropped to 2-6, 1-3.

Despite the contrasting records Lewisburg did not take Warrior Run lightly. The Green Dragons came out hard quickly tallying 10 points before the Defenders could score.

“I was just proud of our guys mindset,” said Lewisburg coach John Vaji. “They didn’t look at records.

“I’m proud of their mental preparation and focus.”

Allen, Matt Fedorjaka, Jesse Flannery and Wil Siigl finished with 17, 16, 10 and 10 points respectively. Any anyone of them could have decided to make it a career night. Instead they looked for each other.

“The nice thing is these guys get along so well,” said the Lewisburg coach. “Whenever guys had good shots they’re making the extra pass for a great shot.”

“The intelligence level is high on this team,” said Flannery. “Everybody knows the situation on the court.”

It made it hard on the Defenders who despite the blowout played hard throughout and knocked down shots of their own. Callen Foresman led Warrior Run with 12 and Zack Miller chipped in 10.

“(Jeff Pealer) does a good job with them,” said Vaji. “They battle.”

“You can see improvement from the beginning of the season and that’s a credit to the coach.”

This afternoon Lewisburg entertains Selinsgrove. And Tuesday the Green Dragons make a much anticipated road trip to Loy-alsock.

“We’re really looking forward to it,” said Flannery. “We take it one game at a time but we’re very excited about it.

“It should be a great game. That’s been circled on the schedule for some time.”
