Lewisburg put together one last rally in the fourth quarter led by sophomore Akilah McFadden who poured in five points, and a three pointer apiece from Amanda Kelly and Emily Conrad but the hole the Dragons had dug was too much to overcome.

After the game, Shamburg stated "it was a good win, the first time we have played a complete game."

Emily Webb and Madi Welliver each added eight for the Defenders.

Conrad and McFadden each had 10 for the Dragons.
