## **BANGOR ATHLETIC DEPARTMENT** Fall 2020 Spectator Procedures

Due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, the Bangor Area School District will implement the following spectator admission procedures to remain in compliance with the Pennsylvania Governor's current order on event gatherings. The current order restricts mass gatherings to 250 people for outdoor events and 25 people for indoor events. All players, coaches, managers, referees, security, and event staff must be included in the totals. As the Governor's Order changes or any new laws are passed, these procedures will be amended.

Please be advised that the procedures listed below will be consistent at all Colonial League Schools as per the Colonial League's "Game Day Action Plan."

## Field Hockey Varsity / JV

- Parents and siblings ONLY from all teams are permitted to attend.
  - $\circ$  Spectators will only be permitted at the top of the field on the end of the lower parking lot.
  - Many away contests will be livestreamed or recorded by opposing schools. Links will be provided as soon as they are available.
- Six Foot Social Distancing and Wearing a Face Covering will be required when attending our events for the safety of the participants, coaches, referees, event staff, and other spectators.
  - Event will not start or will be suspended until everyone complies.
- Spectators are encouraged to bring lawn chairs so that they can properly socially distance
  - Household families may cluster closer than 6 feet.
- Parents and siblings with players playing in the first contest of any Varsity / JV doubleheader are asked to exit the facility at the conclusion of the first contest.
  - Parents and siblings with players playing in the second contest are asked to arrive 15 minutes prior to the stated game time.
- Spectators will not be permitted to interact with teams after the contest on our campus. Upon conclusion of the contest, spectators must exit the facility to their vehicles.
