After graduating the most decorated senior class in the brief history of our program (3 individual state championships, 13 individual state placements, and a Region 6 team championship), this team is young, but still very talented as evidenced by our preseason top 10 state ranking and preseason region favorite.

The coaching staff welcomes back former Bearcat head coach Dave Barnes to the program. Dave will be a huge asset in developing our young wrestlers into contenders by the post season.
