A great weekend of wrestling at Lindsey Wilson College for the Small School State Dual Championship. A tremendous team effort resulted in the Bearcats bringing home a 3rd place finish. Entering the event as the 3rd seed, WV had two dominant wins in pool action (51-27 over McCreary Central and 57-21 over Martin County) before moving onto the semifinals. In a tight battle that featured huge pins by 7th graders TJ Meyer and Luke Hyden, the Bearcats came up just short in the semis, losing 42-39 to Larue County. In the final dual of the day, WV had another barnburner that came down to the final match of the dual where second year wrestler Nathan Harward pulled out a pin to give the Bearcats 6 points and the 39-37 victory for 3rd place overall.

Wednesday, January 29 WVHS will host Conner and Dixie Heights for our Senior Night. We hope to see a huge crowd to celebrate Tristan Spalding, Colton Maines, and Daulton Mayer take the mat for the last time at home. Senior recognition will start at 6:00 pm and wrestling will begin immediately after.
