Week 3 = Ben Walton – another young middle schooler wrestling tough at the varsity level had 3 pins on Friday night at Cov Cath and has stepped up to help solidify and fill out our lineup

1st @ 120 lbs: Senior Spencer Moore (14-0) - pins over #4 Benner (Great Crossing) and #6 Stanley (Holmes)

6th @ 126 lbs: Sophomore Hunter Isaacs (13-1) – win over #16 Armentano (Great Crossing)

2nd @ 132 lbs: Junior Isaac Thornton (5-0) – decision over #5 Cain (Johnson Central), techfall over #15 (@ 138) Roberts (Great Crossing), and major decision over #16 Zinser (Scott)

11th @ 138 lbs: Sophomore Mason Schweitzer (13-1) – decision over #11 (@ 132) Shaddix (Great Crossing), #22 Green (Holmes), and #24 Davis (Johnson Central)

8th @ 160 lbs: 8th grader Luke Hyden (12-2) – lost to #14 (@ 152) Castle (Johnson Central) and #16 (@ 152) Strayer (Great Crossing)

2nd @ 195 lbs: Senior Brandon Gibson (12-2) – lost huge battle with #1 Rodriguez (Johnson Central)
