The team was significantly short-handed last Saturday as our 8th graders were competing at the middle school regional championship and injuries have hampered us this year. But the guys who stepped on the mat stepped up and did their job for the team to be competitive even with 6 holes in the lineup. Dual meet results were:

Wrestlers of the Week:

Week 1 = Jakob Baum - Senior Jakob Baum gets a pin for his first career varsity win against Dixie Heights

Week 2 = TJ Meyer – one of our young, talented middle schoolers competing well at the varsity level, TJ had a huge pin over a top 20 opponent to help secure the victory over Conner

Week 3 = Ben Walton – another young middle schooler wrestling tough at the varsity level had 3 pins on Friday night at Cov Cath and has stepped up to help solidify and fill out our lineup

Week 7 = Spencer Moore – the senior pinned the #4 and #6 ranked wrestlers in the state on his way to a 5-0 record on senior day; Isaac Thornton – finally made his WV debut after knee surgery going perfect on the day with wins over 3 ranked opponents; Mason Schweitzer – has been an animal in practice the last couple weeks with 3 ranked wins on Saturday; TJ Sulfsted – young guy continues to prepare and manage his weight well and getting big wins for the team

Week 8 = Peyton Mayer – Peyton is constantly seeking input and instruction from the coaches and started to show some flashes of Mayer magic on top this weekend; Tyler Kennedy – the young 8th grader is thrown to the wolves on a daily basis with our lightweight group soaking up the knowledge to get better each day, he battled through one of the largest brackets at middle school regions to make the finals and qualify for MS State

Week 9 = CJ Holt – another middle school wrestler who has been wrestling up helping the varsity team in duals and putting in work to get better every day, made his first trip to the middle school state tournament last weekend and came up one match from placing
