It was a very, very busy Christmas break for the Bearcats. The action started with the girls traveling to Jessamine County for the Lioness Tournament where we came home with Sophie Anderson as the champion at 132 lbs and tournament outstanding wrestler, Emma Moore runner-up at 107 lbs, and Emily Stephenson runner-up at 114 lbs. With our small group, this was another event where we finished well as a team (6<sup>th</sup> of 13 teams) while competing against some of the top teams in the state and were only a couple of wrestlers short of bringing home a team trophy.

The very next day the boys traveled to Middletown, OH for the Southwest Ohio Wrestling Coaches Association (SWOWCA) Coaches Classic. This tough 41 team 2-day event included some of the best team in southern Ohio featuring nationally ranked Lasalle. The Bearcats finished in 9<sup>th</sup> overall and 2<sup>nd</sup> in the small school division behind Legacy Christian Academy. Individual placers were TJ Meyer (2<sup>nd</sup> at 138 lbs), Luke Hyden (2<sup>nd</sup> at 215 lbs), Ben Walton (6<sup>th</sup> at 175 lbs), and Liam Bird (7<sup>th</sup> at 150 lbs).

After a brief Christmas holiday, the Bearcats returned to Ohio for the Greater Miami Valley Wrestling Association (GMVWA) Holiday Tournament. This 2-day tournament is even bigger with 67 teams and included national powerhouse St Paris Graham and nationally ranked Buford (GA). WV finished 13<sup>th</sup> overall and 5<sup>th</sup> in the small school division. Individual placers were TJ Meyer (2<sup>nd</sup> at 132 lbs), Luke Hyden (3<sup>rd</sup> at 215 lbs), and Brennen East (8<sup>th</sup> at 113 lbs).

It is such an accomplishment to make the podium at one of these events, so it is impressive for these guys to be competing and placing at both.

With school back in session the action will not slow down at all. This Thursday the boys will compete in the Sectional Duals at Newport where they will look to qualify for the State Dual Championship later this month. Also on Thursday the girls will wrestle Simon Kenton and Highlands in a tri meet at SK. Then the girls will be traveling to Owensboro on Saturday for the Daviess County Tournament and a chance to see some western ky competitors as we prepare for the post season.
