



Ozark Conference MS Wrestling Tournament



Dear Wrestling Coaches:

This year's middle school tournament will be held at Waynesville High School (200 GW Lane Waynesville, MO 65401) on Saturday, December 9th. As we approach the tournament, there are a few bulleted items for you to be aware of.

- An invoice and cost-share sheet will be sent to each school after the completion of the tournament.
- Entries will be due in TrackWrestling no later than 12:00 PM Thursday, December 7th. *When submitting rosters, please declare scoring or non-scoring and level of wrestler.*

- A middle school coaches meeting will start at 8:45 a.m. in front of the large wall graphic in the main gym.
- The tournament will start at approximately 9:00 a.m. The doors for spectators will open at 8:00 a.m.
- The tentative schedule for the tournament will be as follows (subject to change once all entries are in):

- Three tournaments will be conducted simultaneously, two scoring tournaments (Called Boys and Girls Scoring in trackwrestling) and a non-scoring tournament (Called Non-Scorers in trackwrestling). There will be 18 weight classes in the boys tournament (weight classes derived from USA Wrestling), and each school will be allowed one entry per weight class in the boys scoring division. Non-scoring for BOYS will be unlimited entries. **The BOYS scoring Brackets for each weight class will be 16-man double elimination brackets revealing the top four finishers. Non- Scoring BOYS Brackets will be Madison Block (up to 5 man round robins). The GIRLS scoring brackets will be Madison Block (5 woman round robins).**
- The weight classes will be as defined: 78, 85, 90, 95, 100, 106, 113, 120, 126, 132, 140, 150, 160, 170, 180, 195, 220, 285.

- The tournament will be scored on Trackwrestling.com under the name 2023 Ozark MS Conference Championships.
- Match length will be 1-1-1 periods. Overtime rules will be in effect.
- Awards will be distributed to the coaches after all wrestling has been completed. Awards will be given as follows:
 - Medals to the Top 4 Wrestlers in each weight class for BOYS Scoring brackets and Top 3 Wrestlers for GIRLS Scoring Round Robin.
 - Championship & Runner-Up plaques will be awarded to each BOYS and GIRLS team.
- Weigh-ins and skin checks will be conducted onsite starting at 7:45 AM.
- Admission is \$3 for adults, \$2 for students.
- MSHSAA guidelines will be closely followed.
- A hospitality room will be provided for coaches, workers, bus drivers, school administrators.
- Athletic training services and medical coverage will be provided by Waynesville R-VI School District AT's.

Championship Bracket Quarterfinals (Round 2)

Fall, Default, Disqualification, Forfeit	2 + 2 Advancement = 4
Technical Fall	1.5 + 2 Advancement = 3.5
Major Decision	1 + 2 Advancement = 3
Decision	0 + 2 Advancement = 2

Championship Bracket Semifinals (Round 3)

Fall, Default, Disqualification, Forfeit	2 + 2 Advancement + 10 Placement = 14
Technical Fall	1.5 + 2 Advancement + 10 Placement = 13.5
Major Decision	1 + 2 Advancement + 10 Placement = 13
Decision	0 + 2 Advancement + 10 Placement = 12

Consolation Wrestle Backs 1 and Wrestle Backs 2 (Round 3)

Fall, Default, Disqualification, Forfeit	2 + 1 Advancement = 3
Technical Fall	1.5 + 1 Advancement = 2.5

Consolation Semifinals (Round 4)

Fall, Default, Disqualification, Forfeit	2 + 1 Advancement + 4 Placement = 7

Major Decision	1 + 1 Advancement + 4 Placement = 6

3rd / 4th Place Match(Round 5)

Fall, Default, Disqualification, Forfeit	2 + 3 Placement Points = 5
Technical Fall	1.5 + 3 Placement Points = 4.5
Major Decision	1 + 3 Placement Points = 4
Decision	0 + 3 Placement Points = 3

Championship Finals (Round 6)

Fall, Default, Disqualification, Forfeit	2 + 4 Placement Points = 6
Technical Fall	1.5 + 4 Placement Points = 5.5
Major Decision	1 + 4 Placement Points = 5
Decision	0 + 4 Placement Points = 4

Wrestlers will obtain 2 points for a bye after they win in the next round on the championship side. Wrestlers will obtain 1 point for a bye after they win in the next round on the consolation side. No points will be earned for a bye if the wrestler loses in the next round.
