**Tournament Seeding:** For accurate seeding please be sure wrestlers Track Wrestling results are up to date. The tournament committee will be seeding the tournament. There will be no coaches seeding meeting for the tournament.

\*\*Deadline for submitting all entries is 11:59 on Wednesday, January 10

**Rosters:** Teams will be limited to 14 Varsity wrestlers, one per weight class, for both boys and girls. EXTRAS ARE NOT to be entered online. If there are weight classes with openings all coaches will be contacted with availability. Extras will be entered as JV wrestlers on a first submitted basis. Any extras brought Friday evening or Saturday morning will be considered in the event of scratches but entry into the tournament is not guaranteed. Bringing unconfirmed extras is done at your own risk.

<u>Coaches:</u> You MUST enter all information on Track Wrestling for a wrestler to be considered for a seed. Per the seeding criteria, we will seed the Top 6 wrestlers and place them into a 16 man bracket with modified wrestleback rounds due to MSHSAA's 5 match limit per day. We will have a brief coaches scratch meeting in the Hospitality Room (FACS lab – Room C117) on Friday afternoon and Saturday morning after weigh-ins to confirm brackets. The following seeding criteria will be used: Rank Wrestling criteria, previous year State Medalists, previous year State Qualifiers, significant tournament place, record.

Admission: Gates will open to the public at 3:30pm on Friday and 8:00am on Saturday. Admission is \$5 per person, 6 & under are free.

- Boys 7:30 AM Saturday

Upon arrival please send a representative to the head table to turn in the official weigh in sheet and receive an unofficial tournament weigh in sheet for review and correction. Completed weigh-in sheets will be available after weigh-ins.

- The scales will be open before the official weigh-ins beginning at 2:30pm on Friday and 7:00am on Saturday. Multiple scales will be available for weigh-ins. Weigh-Ins will take place in our Auxiliary gym.
- Please be sure to bring your official weigh-in forms and official MSHSAA Skin Forms

<u>Coaches Meeting:</u> There will be a brief coaches meeting held at 3:30pm on Friday and 8:00am on Saturday in the Hospitality Room for all coaches and officials. This meeting will be used to discuss any changes or procedures for the day's activities and for answering questions which need to be addressed.

If you make the semis you are guaranteed top 4. We will wrestle out to 16<sup>th</sup>, and wrestlers will get between 4-5 matches.
