Northwest High School is excited to host the Class 4 and 5 District 5 Track and Field Meet.

- Please let your fans know that there will be a \$6 admission fee entering the stadium.
- Big River Race Management will be timing the meet.
- Please register at mo.milesplit.com. Registration closes on May 7th at 12:00 PM. You must only use official times and marks achieved this season and published on Milesplit.
- There will be a coaches meeting at 8:45 a.m. Saturday morning in the Northwest High School cafeteria. The meeting will have scratches only. No substitutions will be permitted except in the event of illness/injury when such is certified in writing to the meet manager by the MSHSAA Office.
- All certified coaches listed on the MSHSAA pass list will receive a wristband allowing access to the track and coaches boxes. There will be hospitality for coaches wearing wrist bands (pizza and bottled water) around lunch time near the concession stand. (Pass lists are due by Thursday, May 9th at 12 PM)
- Athletes must be in uniform to enter the competition area.
- Tents may only be set up in the grass field between the concession stand and the long and triple jump.
- Northwest will not provide locker rooms. There will be a concession stand.
- The bullpen will be located near the 50 yard line. There will be a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd call for each event 15, 10, and 5 minutes before the event is scheduled to start. After the 3rd call, athletes will be lined up and escorted to the starting line.
- Implement weigh in will take place at the shed between the shot put and javelin area behind the grandstands. The morning weigh-ins will be from 8:00 to 9:30. Approved implements will be collected and transported to the competition site. As per rule, competitors may not use another school's implements without permission from that school.
- Buses will be asked to drop off athletes near the track and then park in front of the school.
- There will be an athletic trainer on site set up with a tent near the universal start/finish line.

Restrictions and Limitations:

- Only one-fourth inch spikes or less may be used on the track and all weather field event surfaces including javelin. Tennis balls
 only may be used on the track. The throwing circles are concrete. Chalk is allowed for long, triple, pole vault, and javelin (all
 weather surface) so long as it is off to the side of the actual runway (no tape). High Jumpers may have two marks on the jumping
 surface, but no continuous "J" or mark with dimensions exceeding 6".
- Athletes may provide their own blocks, but we will have a cart with starting blocks available at the starting line for each race.
- The south side of the turf field is for coaches and athletes warming up only, and no food is allowed on the turf. All athletes not warming up need to be off of the field area and away from the bullpen. Coaches and athletes may not set up camp on the field.
- All field events will be flagged off to designate the restricted competition area. The athlete warm up area designated on the field
 is considered unrestricted as well as any area where spectators are allowed. There will be clearly marked coaches boxes for each
 field event and coaches wristbands will be required for entry. Filming and viewing of video must take place in a coaches' boxes or
 unrestricted area. Both Coaches and Athletes must be within the coach's box or unrestricted area to view video.
- All events will follow the attached time schedule. Delays for weather related issues and schedule adjustments will be determined by the head umpire, Meet Manager, and Athletic Administrator in consultation with the Games Committee.
- Heats/Flights will be seeded by time and distance. There will be no prelims in running events this year.
- Field event participants will get three attempts in prelims with the top 9 going to finals where they will have three more attempts. Long and Triple will be run cafeteria style and close after 90 minutes with finals immediately following. Throws will run to completion with finals immediately following. Starting heights for field events will be decided by the games committee. High Jump will go up by 5 centimeters per height, and vault 15.
- Athletes competing in field events and running events must check out with the field event judge and will have **20 minutes** to complete their event and return to the event.

Awards: The top 4 finishers will qualify for the sectional meet and earn medals which can be picked up by a coach from the pressbox at the end of the meet.

Scoring: 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1.

Workers: Each team will be asked to assist with both a field event and a running event. Work assignments will be listed below. Please bring along help if you are working a field event.
