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Each team will play two games in pool play and a cross pool game on Saturday. If there is a tie within pool play, the tie breaker will be determined in this order. (1) Head-to-head (2) the best run differential with the number of runs divided by the number of innings played (3) fewest amount of runs allowed (4) coin toss

We will supply 4 new baseballs each game. We will be using the Diamond D1-Pro baseballs. Each team should bring some new baseballs because if balls are not shagged by players, you will need to have some ready to go. The team listed second and in bold print will be the home team on games Thursday and Friday. We will have a coin toss to determine the home team each game on Saturday. There will be no infield pregame after the first game that you play. Salem will use the $3^{\text {rd }}$ base dugout during all of their games.

Below are the two pools and it is important that you're prepared for schedule changes if inclement weather occurs as we might have to start games earlier, play later, or play more games on any of the dates as weather might dictate.

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## ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Reminder to bring a few additional baseballs for each game you play in case the four baseballs provided get thrown out by an umpire for a busted seam or blemish or players don't get foul balls back quick enough.

Teams should bring their own water cooler/water bottles for their team.

We will have a concession stand operating throughout the tournament and would appreciate teams supporting it as all profits go to the baseball program. We use our tournament profits so we can continue to supply baseballs, purchase diamond dry in case it is necessary, and purchase our tournament trophy and all tournament plaques. We will be selling pulled pork, hamburgers, hotdogs, chips, candy, nachos, popcorn, and various types of beverages.

The tournament champion will receive a nice team plaque.
Each team's head coach will need to notify me via text or email of whom they select on their team to be on the all-tournament team. Coaches shouldn't share that with anyone so parents or players don't get upset with you over who did or didn't make the all-tournament team. Coaches know their own players better than anyone and we want the right people selected.

Both teams ending up $3^{\text {rd }}$ in their pool will get to choose one player to be on the all-tournament team. Both teams ending up $2^{\text {nd }}$ in their pool will get to choose two players to be on the all-tournament team. Both teams ending up $1^{\text {st }}$ in their pool will get to select three players to be on the all-tournament team. The team winning the tournament will get to also pick one player to receive the tournament MVP plaque which means the champion gets to recognize 4 total players.

There is a total of $\mathbf{1 2}$ all-tournament team members and one MVP.
