## OJRHS Athletic Eligibility/ Academic Standing

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Please read the following terms carefully. These terms outline academic eligibility for all athletes. These terms are created and upheld by the Owen J Roberts School District and are not specific to cheerleading nor were they created by the OJRHS Cheerleading program. Please sign and date at the bottom to indicate your understanding of the terms of participation.

## Academic Eligibility

A student shall pursue a program of studies approved by the respective school principal. All courses will count toward eligibility. To participate, a student cannot receive a failing grade in more than one (1) subject area. All student athletes must meet the minimum PIAA eligibility requirements. To participate in any extracurricular and or interscholastic activity students must meet the specified criteria.

- Athletic eligibility will be cumulative from the beginning of the marking period and will be reported on a weekly basis (weekly eligibility is based upon a Sunday/Saturday cycle).
- A student athlete **may** practice during the first week of ineligibility. The student athlete **may not** participate in interscholastic contests during ineligibility.
- If a student athlete is ineligible a second week during the marking period they **may not** practice or participate in interscholastic contests.
- If a student athlete is ineligible a third week during a marking period, they will be **removed** from the team.
- Students failing to meet the eligibility requirements at the conclusion of each marking period will be ineligible to participate in all extracurricular/interscholastic activities for the first 15 school days of the next marking period and may not practice or participate until eligibility requirements are met. This time frame begins on the 1st day report cards are issued or the 1st day of school.
