"I think we'll regroup and get back on track. The kids keep coming to practice with a great attitude," the coach added. "It's a new week and there's new work to be done."

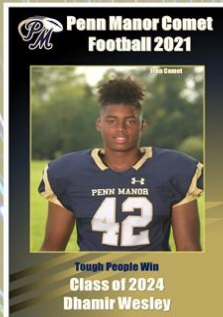
