#### **GUIDES TO ACHIEVING YOUR POTENTIAL**

- Allow for accomplishment through progression
- Develop a strong base before the season
- Have individual goals
- Have team goals
- Show team loyalty
- Strive to run to the best of your ability (desire to excel maximum effort can become a habit)
- Develop self confidence and a winning attitude
- Demand and expect discipline
- Be willing to sacrifice (Sweat + Sacrifice = Success)
- Be patient, realistic and consistent
- Place emphasis on participation rather than coming in first
- Challenge yourself to the limit on occasion (hard runs, long runs and races)
- Avoid injuries, stay healthy
- If willing to pay the price in the summer, you will not have to pay the price in the fall (losing)
