**Report from Board of Directors –**

- Executive council meeting held last week 9/2 to discuss issues. Outcome of decisions are:
- Boosters are generally not contributing towards meals for athletics. Discussion to difficult to come to agreement. Decision was made that Booster deal with equipment and helping with expensive items such as spirit packs or kids with needs and teams to work out meals.
- Sports programs are typically handled by cheerleading since cheerleading has not requested to use as their fundraiser. Booster did coordination of programs so boosters will let each sport sell at their event and they get 25% of the revenue and Booster get 75%.
- Teams – Girls basketball, Boys basketball, Wrestling and football all asked for HUDL web product. For use of viewing game films with players/coaches. Cost 1200.00. Booster agreed to pay. Swim and Baseball taking a look at HUDL
- Spring Mills Athletics.org website will be picked up by booster at cost of 120.00 per month.
- Athletic Director and Booster President discussed which organization will pay for which item.
- Concession stands outdoors were not passed by health department to prepare food. The Band arranged to have prepared food to sell at football games. Gave them loan to get outdoor concession. To be paid back by November 1, 2013.

- Looking for someone to handle hospitality area for sponsors. Will need monies for snack trays, donuts etc... Booster will pay for snacks trays...etc.
