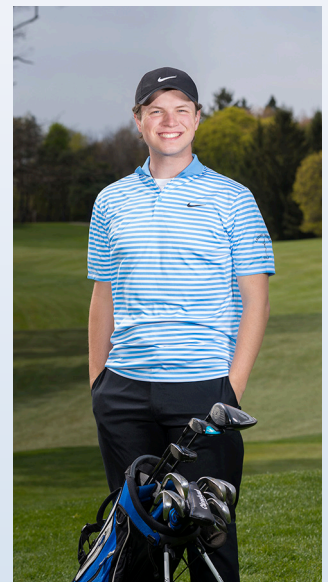


### **KEVIN BIERGANS**

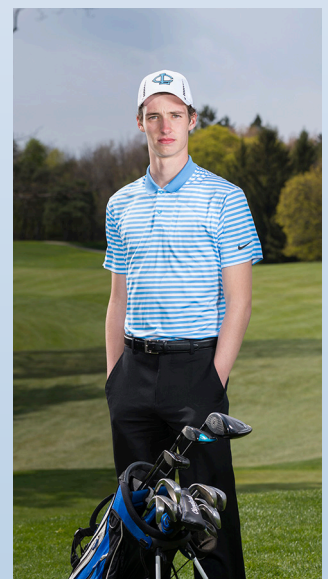

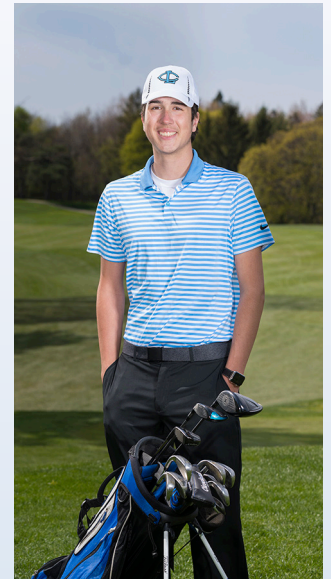


**ANGELO GREENBURG**
