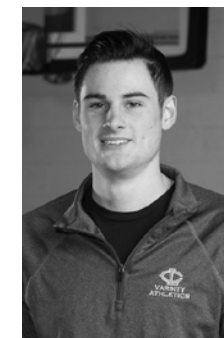

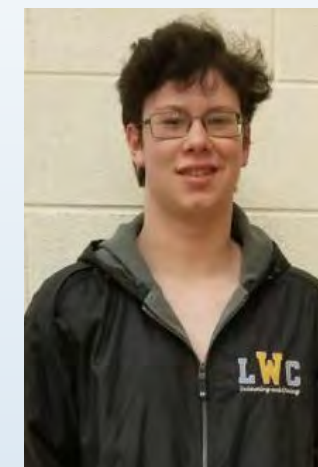


SEBASTIAN SHOAF
