Oceanside Home Varsity Football Games:

- Spectators are to enter and exit the campus through the South parking lot on Skillman Avenue and enter the field using the walkway adjacent to the tennis courts.
- PTA Concession stands are available for all patrons and will sell coffee, water, soft drinks, and food.
- The Oceanside High School campus is alcohol, drug, vape, and smoke-free.
- ***No backpacks, coolers, outside bottles, yetis, coffee cups, or solo cups/no drinks of any kind are permitted. Bicycles are not allowed to be ridden on the property and must be locked up.***
- No tailgating.
- No horns, noisemakers, etc. (NYSPHSAA and Section VIII policy)
- Restrooms will be available for all patrons.
- Campus parking is limited, so please plan accordingly.

Sportsmanship: A Standard of Excellence

- Profanity, racial or ethnic comments, or other intimidating actions directed at officials, student-athletes, coaches, or team representatives will not be tolerated and are grounds for immediate removal from the site of competition.
- Refrain from "coaching from the sidelines." which is a distraction and inhibits performance.
- Respect the judgment of coaches and officials' decisions. A scoreboard does not give you the right to demean and act inappropriately toward anyone.
- All spectators must remain off the playing surface, away from the players' benches, locker rooms, and equipment.
- As per NYSPHSAA rules, noisemakers, air horns, and all other items that can be used to be a nuisance or safety concern to spectators and athletes are prohibited at all times.

Our school district supports relationships based on trust, decency, and fairness. Oceanside athletic contests are held in the spirit of healthy competition and good sportsmanship. We expect cooperation and respect from all athletes and spectators at home and away contests. District Administration reserves the right to remove anyone who is not adhering to the guidelines.
