Chasing Greatness is organized to support persons 18 years and younger with hearing loss by creating funding opportunities for hearing aids and the enhancement of life skills. Our wish is to spread awareness about individuals who experience hearing loss and educate others about the topic. Our team strives to expand the development skills needed to contribute to a greater society. Opportunities will include building upon leadership attributes, athletic skill development, and personal growth qualities such as character building and positive self-pride.

What to expect? Fans will remain silent from the opening serve until Northviewm Varsity scores its ninth point in the first set. The ninth point was chosen in honor of Jonni Parker, the former Nittany Lions who has moderate hearing loss.

What we need from you? All parties, Northview Volleyball, Whitmer Volleyball and Chasing Greatness will have baskets for a basket raffle and we will be doing a 50/50 where all proceeds go to support Chasing Greatness. 
FUNDRAISERS
