#### For our new and returning athletes:

• Starting Tuesday, January 9, 2024 - Every Tuesday and Thursday from 6:00 A.M. to 7:00 A.M. Northview Volleyball will be having Optional Weight Lifting in the Fitness Center at Northview High School. These are optional, but highly recommended as strength training will provide us that additional edge in our skillset. Returning athletes should prioritize attending at least once per week, if not twice. For those that have weight lifting as part of their club volleyball experience, you should attend when applicable, but athletes should be weight training at least once per week, whether at Northview or at their club, or a combination of the two.

### SUMMER CAMPS
