OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the Northview Athletic Booster Club Scholarship are to:

- Reward outstanding graduating high school seniors for their athletic, academic and leadership achievements as student athletes
- Provide financial assistance in order that they may accomplish their future educational goals

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

In order to qualify for consideration, the Applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Be a graduating NVHS senior
- Have played/managed any varsity sport at NV
- Not be receiving a full scholarship
- Submit a copy of their college acceptance letter, if available
- Have an active Family or Student NABC Membership
- Submit evidence of grade point average
- Family/Student have volunteered at least twice each school year with NABC
- Attach your essay
- Complete the application in full and turn in by deadline

AWARD SELECTION PROCEDURES

All athletes meeting the application requirements will be evaluated and scored based on the criteria listed in the scoring section. An outside panel will review all applications received, score each applicant, and make final recommendations to the NABC Executive Board, who will approve the award winners.

RECOGNITION

The NABC will award a minimum of five (5) scholarships for \$500 each. Scholarships will be presented to the Students by the President or other officer of the NABC during the Senior Awards Assembly.

Descriptions of Scholarship Application Categories & Scoring
TOTAL POINTS POSSIBLE: 100

Athletic Participation (30 points)

Points for athletic participation are based on all sports in which the student-athlete participated while at Northview.

Athletic Achievement (10 points)

Points for athletic achievement are based on individual awards and accomplishments that the applicant received while participating in sports at Northview. All recognition received for grades 9-12 sport participation is eligible.

Academic Achievement (15 points)

Academic Achievement points will be based on Unweighted Grade Point Average

4.0 = 15 points

3.5-3.9 = 11 points

3.0-3.4 = 7 points

2.5-2.9 = 3 points

Leadership/Community (15 points)

Points are awarded to our student-athletes who become leaders not only on their team but in our school or community by giving their time to make a difference.

Essay (15 points)

This is based on your 250 word essay explaining how participating in athletics has impacted the applicant's life and how it will benefit you in the future.

Volunteering (15 points)

Points based on family/applicant's volunteering within the NABC organization. Concessions, Wildcat Welcome Days, Reverse Raffle, Fill-it-Up Night, Spirit Store, Golf Outing or any other NABC sponsored events.
