The 2018/2019 season was another **HUGE** success for the SWGHS Men's Baseball Booster Club. However, none of this could have been accomplished without the volunteers of its members, the Executive Committee and the support of the Parents, Coaches and our Athletic Director.

On the field, the 2019 Baseball Team had a great year. The JV team finished with a 11-4 record, winning the conference title for the first time in many years. The Varsity Team finished with a 20-8 record. They were the Piedmont 3A regular session champions for the 4th year in a row. They earned an 8th place seed in the State Playoffs and made it to the 3rd round of the playoffs.

As the season wrapped up we have to share some of the individual accolades. Off the field, the team and Booster Club made great improvements to the baseball facilities at SW. With a generous \$9,400 donation from the main booster club Capital Committee, we were able to replace the aging wooden fence with a chain link fence around the entire outfield including a wind screen and fence capping. Through additional generous donations we were also able to purchase a pitching machine, mound tarps, and new on-deck circles.

### **2018/2019 Men's Baseball Financials:**

SWGHS Men's Baseball Team has had another outstanding financial year to go along with a very successful season. During this past year, through Donations, Fundraisers, our Concession Stand, and the Annual Reverse Raffle/Silent Auction, we have generated \$14,400 in revenue for use by the Men's Baseball program. Below are some Key Fundraising Income/Expenditures that are designated to help and improve our Student Athletes.

- ❑ Equipment/Supplies: \$3,457 (includes fence guard, mound tarps, on deck circles, pitching machine)
- ❑ Baseball Concession Stand Expenses: \$1,390
- ❑ Concession Stand Profit shared with Softball (40%): \$603
- ❑ Uniforms/Hats: \$743
- ❑ Field Repairs: \$720
- ❑ Team Meals: \$516
- ❑ Senior Night: \$191

## **Year End Financial Totals:**

The financial status for the booster club remains strong. We started the school year with a positive balance of \$8,004 and as of June 2019, have a positive balance of \$9,806.
