At MSU, he received a Bachelor of Arts in Finance and was well known for his Spartan Spirit. The Robby Atherton Foundation Scholarship will assure that Rob's legacy, love of life and spirit of giving will live on in the memories of all that knew him. We will remember the life he lived and the countless hearts he touched, for surely it was his greatest achievement. Forever, the Champion of Our Hearts.

The Robby Atherton Foundation has established two (2) \$2,000.00 scholarships to help deserving IKE student-athletes continue their academic careers. The scholarships will be awarded to players who strive to obtain the highest level of performance – on and off the court/field – through dedication, perseverance, sportsmanship, leadership and teamwork. The two scholarships are:

- The Robby Atherton Foundation IKE Basketball Award
   One (1) \$2,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified senior on the Eisenhower
   Varsity Boys Basketball team.
- 2. The Robby Atherton Foundation Eisenhower Varsity Athlete Award
  One (1) \$2,000.00 scholarship will be awarded to a qualified Eisenhower senior boy/girl
  athlete playing a varsity sport. (Varsity Boys Basketball excluded).

### **Eligibility Requirements**

- Applicant must be a graduating senior.
- Applicant must be a varsity athlete.
- Applicant must have a 3.0 or higher grade point average.
- Applicant must be planning to attend a four year accredited college.
- Applicant may not be a family member of the Robby Atherton Foundation or any of its subcommittees nor any of its scholarship judges.
- NOTE: DUE TO NCAA ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS, RECIPIENTS OF FULL COLLEGE ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP.

#### **Selection Process**

- 1. Applications available from Varsity Boys Basketball Coaches, Eisenhower Athletic Director or Counseling office.
- 2. IKE Varsity Boys Basketball Scholarship applications must be postmarked by Friday, Feb 21, 2020.
- 3. IKE Varsity Athlete Scholarship applications must be postmarked by Monday, April 20, 2020.
- 4. A scholarship committee consisting of community and foundation members will review the applications and select winners.
- 5. The IKE Varsity Basketball scholarship will be awarded at the basketball banquet in late March 2020 and the IKE Varsity Athlete scholarship will be awarded in May 2020 at Eisenhower High School's Senior's Honor Night.
- 6. Funds will be directed to the educational institute to be applied to tuition.

- 2. Application is to be completed by applicant.
- 3. Include short leadership essay.
- 4. Include Reference Form filled out from a person other than a relative.
- 5. Include Guidance Form with signed verification.
