## Meeting Minutes September 28, 2015

- I. Call to Order: The meeting was brought to order by President, Karen Moore at 6:30 p.m.

- III. Secretary's Reports:
  - A. Recording (Penny Grimes): The minutes of the August 24, 2015, meeting were distributed via email to the Booster Club members. A motion was made to accept the minutes. Motion was seconded. All were in favor, motion passed.
  - B. Corresponding (Melanie Brown): A Thank you note was received from Tammy Adgate for the flowers she received after the passing of her sister.
- IV. Treasurer's Report (Tammy Adgate):
  - A. Financial Statement and Budget: The budget and financial statement was distributed. Fauquier Bank Checking – \$11,231.35; Savings – \$21,358.73; Accounts Receivable – \$6878.57 (football ads & program sales). All monies have been budgeted. Restricted funds: Petty Cash/Concessions- \$9682.60, Football- \$5192.06, Girls Soccer- \$822.86, Track- \$265.00 , Cheerleading- \$112.69, Randy Moore Scholarship-\$815.00, Roy A. Pool Scholarship- \$144.03.  
A motion was made to accept the financial statement. Motion was seconded. All were in favor, motion was passed.
- V. Committees:
  - A. Committee Assignments (Karen Moore): Still need volunteers/coordinators for Softball, Boys Soccer and Lacrosse. Please let us know if you are willing to help.
  - B. Committee Reports:
    1. Membership (Mary Kay Anderson): Mary Kay reported that as of tonight we have 111 members (22 are Board Members).
  - C. Concessions:
    1. Football (Sharion Rigney): \$2880.00 made from Homecoming game! This is an increase from last year's Homecoming game. There was discussion regarding the purchase of Chick-fil-a sandwiches for the games. It is a very popular item but does not bring in as much revenue as hotdogs and hamburgers. Sharion may consider cutting back on the number ordered for each game.
    2. Volleyball (Martha Janowski): All is going well. Mr. and Mrs. Janowski split the responsibilities of concessions this year with Sherry Railey.
    3. Field Hockey: No report
- VI. Activities Director

A. Report (Mr. Burton, Principal): All sports going well. Golf has done very well, placing 2<sup>nd</sup> and advancing to Harrisonburg. Volleyball is looking forward to home games. Field Hockey lost their first game this season and Football looks like they may have a stretch of good games coming up.
