A new online payment option is now available.

The Fenton Athletic Department is pleased to introduce a new program called **E-Funds for Schools**. This program offers various options for parents/guardians who choose to make payments online and is extremely user friendly. You have the option to have your student's Pay to Participate fee electronically withdrawn from your checking account or charged to your credit card.

The **E-Funds for Schools** service is offered to you by a third-party service provider. They charge for processing your payments, similar to other online banking services. The district does not request or keep records of family checking or credit card account information. *There is a \$1.25 transaction fee for each electronic checking payment.* Please note: The system carries a Non-Sufficient Funds (NSF) charge if there is not sufficient funds in the account to cover the payment. *Payments made by credit or debit card have a transaction fee of \$2.65 per each \$100 increment.* Review your options carefully when you set up your account.

You are in full control of your account and can make a payment at any time that is convenient for you. No payments will be made without your authorization through this secure system. An email notification containing the student's name, purpose of the payment and the amount charged will be sent to you each time a payment is processed. The **E-Funds for Schools** site is secure and uses industry standard data encryption.

How does E-Funds for Schools work?

- Families set up and maintain their own logins, passwords and payment preferences. Your account information is retained in a password protected file.
- **E-Funds for Schools** will help to eliminate last minute check writing hassles, improve efficiencies and help cut costs for both you and the school district.
- Online payments will help eliminate the worry that your children could lose or forget the money intended for school.
- Payments from a credit card or checking account may be set up.
- Parents / guardians may make partial payments through the reoccurring payment option or choose to make a one-time payment.
- Your payment history for the year is available with a click of a button.
