

# Glendale Nine Opens Tomorrow

COALPORT — Glendale opens its second baseball season under Coach Joe Vesnesky tomorrow traveling to Lanss to meet West Branch in the Moshannon Valley League opener.

Vesnesky rates his team's hitting as adequate but lacking in power.

"We will have to rely on running and the bunt," he said. "Our infield is tight defensively and our outfield is fairly good. The catching looks real good."

Pat Pino and Dick Evanskey, two of the Vikings' four returning lettermen, will form the double play combination, with Pino at second base.

Holdover Joe Gresco and Bill Dubler, a freshman, probably will share the first base post.

Howard Kollar will handle the hot corner.

Freshman Jim Washel will be behind the plate.

The Viking pitching chores, for the most part, rest on the arms of John Heverly and LeRoy Beals. If they can't do the job, Vesnesky plans to try Ed Henry, Dubler or Mike Wagner.

One letterwinner and two part-time performers from last year's squad will patrol the outer gardens. Wagner will be in left, Jim Tiesi in center and Dave McClellan in right. Tiesi is the only senior on the team.

All eight games on the Glendale schedule will be against MVL opponents.

Vesnesky has high hopes for this year's team. "I think they'll come around," he added. "We hope to have a winning season."

Since the Glendale School District became a reality, the Vikings have never won a baseball game. They should this year. They were 0-7 last year.
