## Glendale Caps Best Year By Toppling St. Francis

IRVONA — Glendale broke up a 1-1 game with seven runs in the fourth inning and went on to thump Clearfield St. Francis 10-1 yesterday behind one-hit pitching by John Vigne and Jim Wagner.

Victory in the 1970 finale for both clubs was the fourth in 11 games for the Vikings, giving them the best record in the school's history. Coach Ron Karlin, the second year mentor, started most of his seniors before inserting some of his underclassmen.

St. Francis, which hasn't fielded a team in several years, wound up 0-4 under Coach Bill Bently, but underclassmen logged most of the playing time.

A leadoff single by George Riley was the lone hit the Ponies mustered off Vigne and Wagner. Vigne struck out 11 in six innings but had control problems which led to the St. Francis run in the fourth.

Two walks, a wild pitch and a walk gave the Ponies their run, with loser Rick Pasquariello scoring.

Glendale had taken a 1-0 lead

in the first when Bob Koteas singled. Dave McClellan forced him and Vigne singled.

After the Ponies got even, the Vikings broke it wide open. A walk and Mike Wagner's single ignited the rally. Larry Kauffman, Tom Nash and Norm Dobish rapped RBI-singles. After an error permitted another run to score, McClellan came through with a single for another and Vigne tripled for two more.

Randy Miles and Vigne drove in runs in the sixth.

Jim Wagner then set down the Ponies in the seventh, striking out the side.
