## Hurlers Key To Success At Glendale

FLINTON — Glendale baseball coach Ron Kerlin begins his third year at the helm of the Vikings with six lettermen and a dark horse title to carry into the Moshannon Valley League.

Pitching is the name of the game, and Kerlin has junior John Vigne in camp as the only seasoned hurler. After that, he can only hope that the unproven arms can come through.

"The big problem right now is the pitching staff. That's our biggest question mark," said Kerlin. "If we can get that, we should be in the thick of things.

"In the league, I'd say Curwensville and Clearfield are the prime targets for the rest of us. West Branch is too tough to count out yet and, as I said, I hope you'll see the name Glendale up around the top. I honestly think the league race will be just as close as the one we had last year."

Junior Jeff Best, another returnee, is the number two man behind Vigne. Other candidates for the pitching chores are letterman Jeff Wagner and Randy Miles. Bill Dubler and Steve Dudurich. Dubler is the only southpaw.

Along with Vigne, Best and Wagner, centerfielder Bob Koteas is back as are catchers Rick Miles and Jim Washell.

Vigne was slated to pitch today's opener at home against West Branch. When not throwing, he'll be at short. Washell seems to have grabbed the catching spot with Rick Miles and Best in reserve.

First base belongs to Dubler, with Dudurich and Best, the most versatile Viking of all, acting as back-up. Soph Sam Piesi has earned the job at second thanks to a good glove as Rick Miles and John Evanskey offer support. Rick Miles will be at short, with Bill Zupich in reserve, while Wagner has the inside track at third ahead of Mike Vigne and Herb O'Shell.

Koteas is a fixture in center. Flanking him will be leftfielder Randy Miles and rightfielder Dick Noel. Washell and Walter Fiedor will also see action.

The Vikings will play at Clearfield on Friday.

# Vigne Twirls One-Hitter, Glendale Tops Mo Valley

MADERA — Glendale's John Vigne authored a one-hitter yesterday, and it's a good thing he did because his mates weren't scoring many runs.

The Vikings scratched Moshannon Valley hurler George Winters for 11 hits, but they didn't give Vigne any breathing room until the fourth inning when they scored two runs, upping the lead to 3-0.

After that, Vigne was on his own and he proved equal to the task by earning a 3-1 victory, his second as well as the team's.

The Vikes of Coach Ron Kerlin scored in the first as Bill Dubler laced a two-out single and Vigne followed with a triple that turned out to be a single. The run counted, of course, but Vigne had missed second base and was ruled out on an appeal play.

It was two-out lightning which did the trick for the Glendale crew in the fourth frame, also, as Sam Tiesi, Rick Noel, Bob Koteas and Jeff Best stroked consecutive singles and got the benefit of an error for the two runs.

Winters, who always proves to be the toughest out for opposing pitchers, broke up the no-no in the home half of the fourth with a single to center. He stole second, then came home on two fielder's choice plays.

That was all the Black Knights could get, though, as

Vigne fanned 11 batters en route to the victory.

The Vikings will play host to league-leading Clearfield tomorrow while the Knights will wait until Monday for a return battle with the Vikings at Irvona.

## Glendale's Ace Masters Knights For Second Time

IRVONA — A two-out double by Moshannon Valley's Jerry Ludwig in the seventh inning deprived Glendale ace John Vigne of a no-hitter yesterday, making it two times in seven days that he's just missed against the Black Knights.

Vigne, who lost a no no against the Knights last Tuesday on a pop fly single by Don Winters, struck out 12 in the 12-5 win that boosted Coach Ron Kerlin's Vikings into third place in the Moshannon Valley League.

Glendale, headed for the best record in its brief history, is 3-3 in the circuit. Mo Valley is 3-5 against MVL foes and 3-6 for the season.

"John was sharper in last week's one-hitter than he was in this one," Kerlin said. "He was real tough when he got the ball over the plate but he walked eight.

"I was very happy with the win because we haven't practiced since last Wednesday. The kids did an extraordinary job."

The Vikings parlayed five of their 11 hits with two walks and two Knight errors to mount a nine-run charge in the third inning.

An error and bunt singles by Rick Miles and Bob Koteas loaded the bases. Winters walked Sam Tiesi to force in the first run and then balked in the second. With one out, Vigne's grounder was good for an RBI. Best doubled for another run and Jim Washell singled home two more. A walk, Jim Wagner's single and an error completed the rally.

In the fifth, Glendale tacked on its last three runs. Tiesi walked, Bill Dubler and Vigne singled and Best tripled.

Vigne balked home Mo Valley's initial run in the sixth following an error and two walks.

Kerlin used his reserves in the last inning, and three errors helped the Knights score four times. Two miscues and a walk left Knights at every station when Ludwig belted his hit to right center. An overthrow gave the visitors their last pair of runs.

Glendale plays Harmony at Cherry Tree Thursday and hosts Clearfield St. Francis Friday while Mo Valley welcomes Philipsburg - Osceola in a non-league game tomorrow and West Branch in an MVL test Thursday.
