Hurlers Key To Success At Glendale

FLINTON — Glendale baseball coach Ron Kerlin begins his third year at the helm of the Vikings with six lettermen and a dark horse title to carry into the Moshannon Valley League.

. Pitching is the name of the game, and Kerlin has junior John Vigne in camp as the only seasoned hurler. After that, he can only hope that the unproven arms can come through.

"The big proglem right now is the pitching staff. That's our biggest question mark," said Kerlin. "If we can get that, we should be in the thick of things.

"In the league, I'd say Curwensville and Clearfield are the prime targets for the rest of us. West Branch is too tough to count out yet and, as I said, I hope you'll see the name Glendale up around the top. I honestly think the league race will be just as close as the one we had last year."

Junior Jeff Best, another returnee, is the number two man behind Vigne. Other candidates for the pitching chores are letterman Jeff Wagner and Randy Miles, Bill Dubler and Steve Dudurich. Dubler is the only southpaw.

Along with Vigne, Best and Wagner, centerfielder Bob Koteas is back as are catchers Rick Miles and Jim Washell.

Vigne was slated to pitch today's opener at home against West Branch. When not throwing, he'll be at short. Washell seems to have grabbed the catching spot with Rick Miles and Best in reserve.

First base belongs to Dubler, with Dudurich and Best, the most versatile Viking of all, actng as back-up. Soph Sam riesi has earned the job at second thanks to a good glove as Rick Miles and John Evanskey Mer support. Rick Miles will be at short, with Bill Zupich in eserve, while Wagner has the nside track at third ahead of dike Vigne and Herb O'Shell.

Koteas is a fixture in center. lanking him will be leftfielder tandy Miles and rightfielder tick Noel. Washell and Walter lieder will also see action.

The Vikings will play at Clearield on Friday.

Glendale's Ace Masters Knights For Second Time

IRVONA — A two-out double by Moshannon Valley's Jerry Ludwig in the seventh inning deprived Glendale ace John Vigne of a no-hitter yesterday, making it two times in seven days that he's just missed against the Black Knights.

Vigne, who lost a no no against the Knights last Thesday on a pop fly single by Don Winters, struck out 12 in the 12-5 win that boosted Coach Ron Kerlin's Vikings into third place in the Moshannon Valley League.

Glandale, headed for the best record in its brief history, is 3-3 in the circuit. Mo Valley is 3-5 against MVL foas and 3-6 for the season.

"John was sharper in last week's one-hitter than he was in this one," Kerlin said. "He was real tough when he got the ball over the plate but he walked eight.

Vigne balked home Mo Valley's initial run in the sixth following an error and two walks,

Kerlin used his reserves in the last inning, and three errors helped the Knights score four times. Two miscues and a walk left Knights at every station when Ludwig belted his hit to right center. An overthrow gave the visitors their last pair of
