Vikes' Vigne Stops Warriors

ALLPORT — Glendale, rated as a solid contender for Moshannon Valley League honors before the season, lost some of its status in an opening day setback against Curwensville.

The Vikings followed that loss with a couple of routine wins over Clearfield St. Francis and Harmony, but yesterday they re-entered the MVL title picture by shocking previously unbeaten West Branch 3-1 behind the strong pitching of John Vigne.

Vigne gave up five hits and the lone run in the first three frames, then settled down to fire hitless ball the rest of the way, retiring the final 14 Warriors in order to earn his second victory. He struck out seven and walked one along the way.

The other Vikings, meanwhile, scratched Warrior Gary Folmar for single tallies in the second and fourth and then added an insurance run off reliever Mike Lawrence

when Walter Fiedor stole home in the sixth.

The visitors jumped in front in the second when Bill Andrews went the whole way to third on an overthrow and then scored when Jerry Noel's pop-up squeeze bunt fell safely between three West Branch players.

West Branch evened things in the third on an error, a single by Rob Viehdorfer and Don Jones' RBI single.

good in the fourth inning thanks to a single by Andrews, a sacrifice bunt by Fiedor and a base hit by Noel. The extra run in the sixth took some work by Fiedor, who singled, moved up two notches on a walk and a passed ball, then got a big jump and beat Lawrence's delivery to the plate.

After the third, West Branch never mounted anything that resembled a threat against Vigne, who seemingly has regained the form that he lost against Curwensville. He's throwing the way he's capable.

Coach Ron Kerlin's crew, now 3-1 in the loop and for the season, will face Curwensville at home on Monday. West Branch 2-1 in the league and 3-1 over all, will be at home against Harmony on Thursday and against Curwensville on Friday.
