Vikes' Vigne Authors No-Hitter Against Owls

BEAVER VALLEY— Bill Vigne's five-inning no-hitter and two-run home run led the Glendale Vikings to a five-inning 11-0 Moshannon Valley Baseball League victory over the visiting Harmony Owls yesterday afternoon.

Vigne, who got 12 of his 15 outs via the strikeout route, had little trouble holding the Owls, who hit only one ball out of the infield all afternoon.

The Viking righthander did walk eight batters, but Glendale coach Pat Pino attributed that to the field condition.

"Bill pitched a good game, those walks were mostly due to the slippery mound," Pino said, noting that the game was played in a steady drizzle.

And while Vigne was holding the Owls hitless, Glendale was pounding out 11 hits for 11 runs in the four innings the Vikings faced Harmony's Paul Norris.

Vigne helped his own cause with a two-run

homer in the second, but by then the Vikes had already built themselves a 6-0 lead.

Glendale's offense started quickly enough when Viking leadoff batter Bill Vesnesky smacked a roundtripper in the bottom of the first.

Steve Turchick, Todd Cossick and John Weymers all followed with singles to load the bases before Norris finally recorded his first out.

But then Gig Callahan poked a two-run single, Matt Blaschak an RBI-single and Anthony Tiesi a sacrifice fly to make it 5-0.

In the Vikes' second, Vesnesky was hit with a pitch, Turchick walked, both runners advanced on a passed ball and Vesnesky scored on a long fly out by Cossick. One out later, Vigne smacked his two-run homer.

Glendale ended the scoring in the third on a single by Brett Yingling, a double by Brian McClellan, Mike Kutruiff's two-run single, an

error and a sacrifice fly by George Moore.

The Vikes, now 1-0 in the MVBL and 1-1-1 overall, are slated to visit Curwensville Friday at 3 p.m.

Nine-Inning Heart-Breaker Sidelines Vikes

FLINTON — "I hate to see any team lose a game like that," Laurel Valley High School baseball coach Jerry Page said after yesterday's District 6 Class AA quarterfinal.

He wasn't talking about his Rams, however.

The veteran mentor was trying to console Glendale coach Pat Pino after the Rams eked out a 2-1, nine-inning victory to advance to Thursday night's semifinal against Bishop Carroll.

Pino just shrugged his shoulders. His Vikings failed to get a hit off Dennis Henderson until one out in the ninth and never seriously threatened to reward Bill Vigne's gutsy effort.

Vigne worked from the stretch more often than not but always was equal to the task—until the ninth.

He issued his fifth walk to begin the ninth but grabbed Jim Watson's sacrifice attempt and turned it into a force at second base.

Leadoff batter Joe Flickinger, a high-average hitter who had been held in check by Vigne, poked an opposite-field single to left.

Brian Novak fouled out, but Viking first baseman John Weymers crossed the out-of-play line after making the grab, so the two Ram runners advanced on the "catch-and-carry" rule.

Henderson then took matters into his own hands.

After fouling off a pair of 1-2 pitches, he slashed a single to left to chase home Watson and Flickinger.

"They would have gotten only one run if it hadn't been for the "catch-and-carry" play, and Todd (Cossick) just missed the foul tip by Henderson before he got that big hit," Pino lamented. "That's how things have been going for us lately."

Glendale, 9-5-1 and awaiting the outcome of today's Curwensville-Clearfield St. Francis game to see if a Moshannon Valley League championship

playoff will be necessary, kicked up a fuss in the lower ninth.

Cossick, the only Vike who consistently hit the ball hard against Henderson, twice flying deep to center, lined a single to center with one out.

Steve Turchick jumped on a high fastball and drilled it to right center, the ball hopping over the low fence for a ground-rule double, forcing pinch-runner Scott Wagner to stop at third.

Matt Blaschak grounded to short to drive in Wagner, but pinch-hitter Brett Yingling's sharp one-hopper was directly at shortstop Novak, and the sure-handed junior made the game-ending play to first base.

"We could have hung our heads in the last inning, but we came back at them," Pino said. "It's a game of inches, and they got a couple of breaks. I guess it just wasn't meant to be for us."

Pino and Page both praised the pitchers, who hooked up in a classic duel for eight innings.

Pino was concerned about the Vikes' hitting, especially when he saw Henderson warming up. The junior righthander relies on a forkball and curve more than a fastball, and Pino pointed out his team usually has trouble solving that type of a hurler.

The Glendale coach

couldn't have been more prophetic.

Henderson didn't allow a runner past second and had only two shaky innings—the fifth and seventh when he gave up four of his five walks—until the ninth.

"When he's mixing well, he can be tough," Page said. "He started off slowly but has been getting better."

Glendale's senior righty showed a good hummer with an effective curve in settling down 11 Rams via strikes while walking five and hitting one. He yielded only five hits while absorbing his third loss in 11 decisions.

The Viking workhorse was at his best in the late innings when he went to his "heel" to maintain the shutout. In fact, the only innings he retired the winners in order were the seventh and eighth.

Laurel Valley, a perennial playoff entry, takes a 7-9 record into the semis Thursday at 8:30 p.m. at Altoona.

Glendale must practice today in the event Curwensville beats St. Francis. The Vikes concluded MVL action at 9-3, while the Golden Tide is 8-3. If the Tide beats the Ponies, the playoff game probably will be scheduled for Friday.

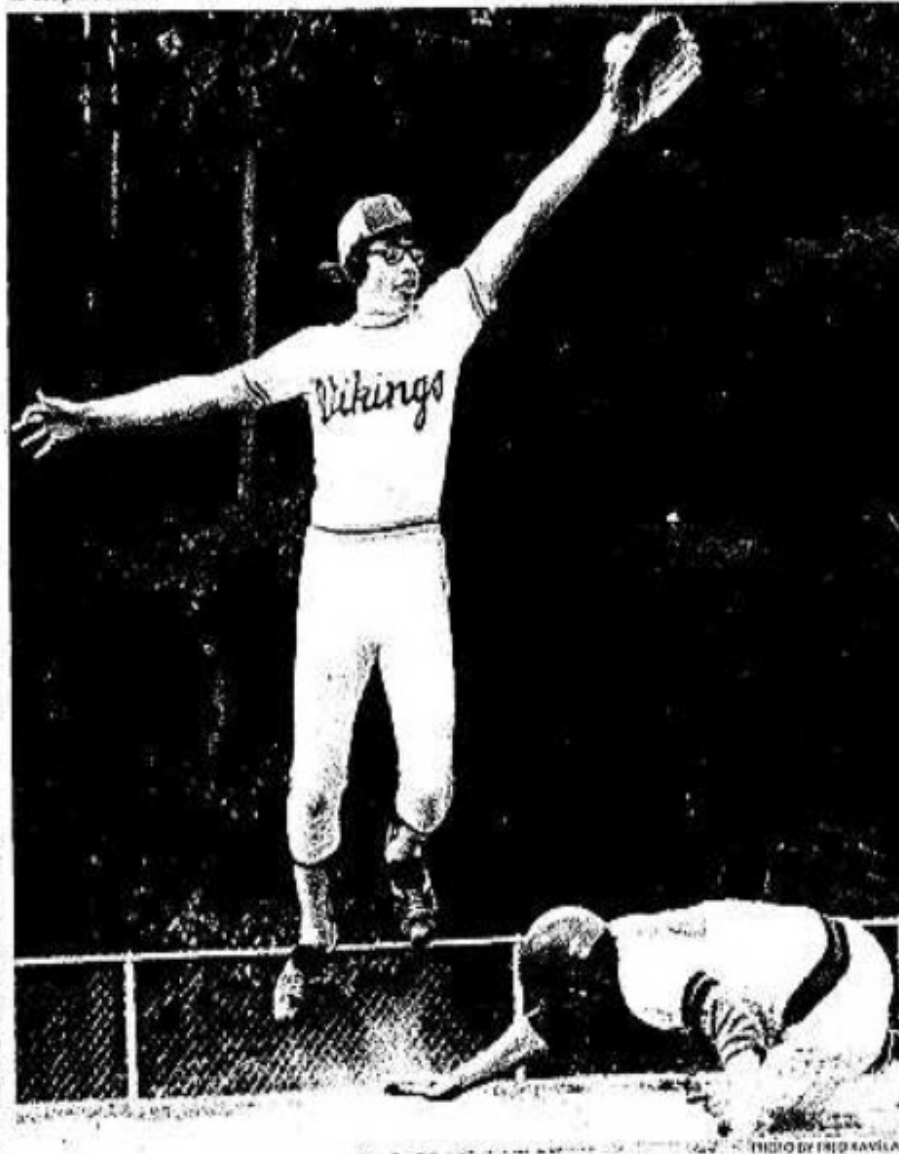
