Vikings Sting Colts on Holes' Dramatic HR

FLINTON — Rick Holes belted a two-run homer with two outs in the bottom of the seventh inning to give Glendale a dramatic 5-3 upset victory over Northern Cambria in a Moshannon Valley League schoolboy baseball game yesterday.

Holes also picked up his first mound victory of the season as he turned in a nine-strikeout, five-hit performance.

The loss was a damaging one for the Colts, who dropped a full game behind MVL front-runner Curwensville, which is 8-1 following a 5-3 victory over Moshannon Valley.

"For the first time this year, we hit the ball with guys in scoring position," said Viking coach Pat Pino, whose club is 2-5. "We only had five hits, but we made two of them count. Holes also pitched a solid game.

"Northern Cambria had guys on second and third with no outs in the sixth, and Holes got them to make three straight outs," he said. "That saved it for us."

Trailing 3-0, the Vikings tied the game in the bottom of the fifth on Kevin Swauger's two-run double and Jeff Hewitt's sacrifice fly.

Glendale will host Curwensville this after-

noon in an MVL makeup game and play Haromny at Westover tomorrow.

FLINTON — Rick Holes fired a no hitter yesterday to start the ball rolling in the right direction for the Glendale High School baseball team, which swept a pair of Moshannon Valley League shutouts, 12-0 and 10-0, over Clearfield St. Francis in makeup action.

Holes, who struck out nine and raised his record to 2-4, narrowly missed his bid for a perfect game, as he issued two free passes in the third inning. No other Pony reached base.

In the nightcap, Kevin

Swauger (2-1) also demonstrated his mound finesse by twirling a five-hitter and fanning 10 to pick up the Vikings' sixth win in the last seven games.

Swauger helped himself by belting a home run and Holes contributed a round-tripper. Roger Renninger slashed a triple and Jeff Noel cracked a double to round out the Vikings' offensive barrage.

In the opener, the Vikings parlayed 10 hits into 12 runs with some good power hitting, in the forms of Noel and Jim Orichosky, both of whom blasted four-baggers and accounted for eight RBI.

"We're really starting to play well now after a slow start," commented Glendale coach Pat Pino. "We're hitting the ball well and putting it in play. When you do that, you'll win some ballgames."

"Rick (Holes) pitched another fine game for us," he continued. "He was never in any real trouble, although (Pony hurler Dan) Wright didn't pitch badly. He

struck out 11 of our hitters and gave up only six earned runs."

St. Francis mentor Rick Hall agreed with his opponent's analysis.

"I thought Danny (Wright) pitched well, except for a couple of hanging curve balls that hurt him," Hall noted. "Glendale hit the ball well and hard, though. You can't take anything away from them. Holes threw a nice game."

"I think not being able to practice at all last week really hurt us, though."

Glendale, now 6-5, will travel to Madera tomorrow for a MVL makeup game with Moshannon Valley, while St. Francis, 1-11, is idle until Tuesday when it hosts Mo Valley.
