Noel Grand Slam Caps Glendale Comeback Win Over Tide

FLINTON — Some things are worth the wait. Just ask Glendale senior baseball player Jamie Noel.

Noel hit a grand slam home run in the bottom of the seventh inning Monday to cap off a furious Glendale rally and lift the Vikings to a thrilling 8-7 win over Curwensville.

Curwensville led the contest 7-2 heading into the final inning, but the Vikes solved Tide hurler Shane London to score six runs in the closing stanza, the last four on Noel's slam.

Glendale Coach Joe Vesnesky was especially pleased for Noel, a player who has waited patiently for his chance to grab the spotlight. Even Monday, Noel didn't enter the game until the seventh inning.

"I feel really good for Jamie right now. He's a senior who has really paid his dues for us. There have been times he hasn't played a lot and could have quit, but he stuck it out and he finally got his shot today," Vesnesky commented.

Noel, who hit a 3-2 pitch over the fence in left center, said he was looking for the pitch he got from Shane London.

"I hit a fastball. That's really what I was looking for and I sat on the pitch. This is the proudest moment of my baseball career here at Glendale," Noel commented.

With the win, Glendale has won three in a row — all in comeback fashion — to improve to 3-8 overall and 2-8 in the Moshannon Valley League. Coach Bear Stewart's Golden Tide, the regular season champs in the MVL, fall to 13-4 and 9-1 in the league.

Although the game ended in Glendale's favor, things looked bleak for the Vikings for most of the game.

Curwensville jumped on top 2-0 in the first inning when Viking starter Steve Wagner suffered through early wildness and gave up bases-loaded walks to the Tide's Chris Fleming and Gene McGee.

Glendale battled back in the bottom of the first frame. After Mike Jasper smacked a triple to right, third baseman Bill Twigg singled to left to deliver the run and cut the Tide lead to 2-1.

The only other scoring in the game before the sixth inning came when Curwensville's Wade Sloppy knocked in Dean Tozer to make the score 3-1 in the fourth.

Both offenses began to heat up in the sixth. Curwensville got RBI singles from Tozer and Russ Sloppy and benefited from a throwing error by Glendale right fielder Frank Hutton to go on top 6-1.

After Glendale added a run to cut the lead to 6-2, Tide senior Sean London led off the seventh with a round tripper over the left field fence to make the score 7-2. But from that point on the game was Glendale's.

Mike Jasper and Dan Holes led off the bottom of the seventh for Glendale with singles. Jasper

scored on a single by Twigg to make it 7-3. Following a Cory Cree single, catcher John Keith grounded out to third to knock in a run and make it 7-4.

Dan Jasper walked to load the bases once again, setting up Noel for his game-winning heroics.

Wagner claimed his third win of the season against only one loss for Glendale despite struggling at times. Vesnesky said his sophomore southpaw got outs when they counted.

"You have to give Steve Wagner credit. He hung in there against a really good Curwensville club. You really have to think Curwensville will do well in the District 9 tournament," Vesnesky said.

Shane London took the loss for the Golden Tide.

Mike Jasper, Holes and Twigg, each had two hits to lead the winners while Russ Sloppy, Chris Fleming and Tozer each lined two hits apiece for Curwensville.

Glendale will close out its season Wednesday when it hosts Juniata Valley while Curwensville will play Oswayo Valley Wednesday afternoon at Clearfield in the District 9 playoffs.
