Vikings win over Harmony, 16-1

FLINTON — Wind can do funny things to a baseball game.

When Glendale (1-3) played host to Harmony yesterday evening the wind was kicking up to 20 mile per hour gusts and sending fielders to and fro in search of generally easy-out fly balls.

Count it as substantial then that the Vikings were able to notch two home runs on their way to a 16-1 win. Steve Wagner went the five-inning distance for Glendale and picked up 12 strikeouts.

Errors would be the demise of the Owls as the visitors committed seven in the game. Harmony (0-2) coach Chad Wiewiora said he was pleased with his starting pitcher, Don Hauser, but after that things went downhill.

"Our fielding was weak," the coach said. "We had some routine fly balls that we didn't field. If the defense was there we would have been in the game."

Glendale picked up five runs in

the first on five hits and two walks. Mike Jasper laid a bunt down the third base line to open the game. Rob Burmeister followed with a single. John Keith, Dan Jasper and Chip Clarkson also had hits in the inning.

Glendale coach Jeff Wagner was pleased with the first win of the year. The Vikings had picked up two losses on Wednesday in the rain and snow in DuBois and the win seemed to rejuvenate his club.

Glendale and DuBois Central Christian finished a game called because of darkness last week and then played a scheduled game.

The Cardinals wound up winning both, 14-11 and 10-4.

"I'm seeing better things," Wagner said. "We have our moments. The hitting is going great, we have to get the defense down and keep our pitchers from throwing balls."

Wagner had five walks in yesterday's game.

Things were indeed clicking on offense against the Owls. Bill Twigg and John Keith homered

in the game. The wind was relatively calm for Twigg's shot over the fence in left-center but Keith had to hit a sharp line drive for the ball to clear the fence in the Vikings' fourth.

Glendale sent 15 batters to the plate in that inning, scoring nine runs on five hits.

The Vikings travel to Moshannon Valley on Monday.
