Vikes clinch first league crown in 15 years, 7-0

CURWENSVILLE - Over the last two years Glendale, Moshannon Valley and West Branch have each won 11 games in Moshannon Valley League play. The only difference between the three schools was the fact the Vikings were the only team not to win a championship.

Until yesterday.

Glendale clinched its first MVL crown since 1981 by blanking Curwensville 7-0 at a cold and rainy Curwensville

High School field.

"The last three years we lost to Curwensville every time at Curwensville and these kids decided they were going to come out here and win the ballgame," said a cold and wet Glendale manager Tom Janowiak. "They wanted to win the league right now; no more monkeying around between raindrops. They just came out today and played a great game.

"These kids wanted it from the beginning of the year, and

they got it."

Senior right-hander Brett Miller helped the Vikings to the crown by limiting the Golden Tide to three hits and one walk, while striking out a career-high 12 batters.

"My curves were breaking pretty well and my fastball had a little bit of speed,"

Miller said.

Miller, who improved to 5-1 on the season, did not allow a base runner past first base and went full-count on just one batter. He threw 94 pitches, 63 for strikes.

"He dominated the game from the beginning," Janowiak said. "The difference tonight was that Brett was throwing strikes. He's a senior, and he's going out in style."

The Vikings (9-2 overall, 7-0 league) gave Miller the only run he would need in the first

inning.

Chuck Oshall led off the game by reaching safely on third baseman Mike Sutika's error. Following a walk to Josh Irvine, Jason Wagner laid down a successful sacrifice bunt to move the runners to second and third.

Paul McClellan then grounded out to shortstop to score Oshall and give Glen-

dale the lead.

The game stayed that way until the third inning when the

Vikings added a pair.

Oshall worked a full-count walk and Irvine reached safely when second baseman Jason Henry's throw pulled Nate Verrelli off the bag at first. Wagner followed with a ball that Henry booted to load the bases.

The Golden Tide (1-11, 1-3) got two big outs when Mc-Clellan grounded into a 6-3 double play. Oshall scored on the play.

Miller then helped his own cause by ripping a triple deep into the right-center field gap to plate Irvine.

"We've taken it a few runs at a time." Janowiak said. "A lot of our big games have been like that where we picked up two runs in this inning, two runs in that inning."

Glendale upped its lead to 5-0 in the fourth as Oshall and Irvine walked with two outs and Wagner smacked a double into left-center to score both runners.

The Vikings ended Curwensville starter Mike Greene's day in the fifth as Miller led off with a single and Mark Smyers walked.

Steve Waroquier relieved and gave up an RBI single to Mike Harpster. Smyers scored later in the inning on the back end of a double steal.

Curwensville hosts West Branch Thursday. Glendale hosts Juniata Valley Monday.

Vikings rip Colts in D-6 playoff opener, 11-1

BEAVER VALLEY - The Glendale baseball team has got this revenge thing down pat.

After falling to Bellwood-Antis 3-1 in the season opener, the Vikings turned the tables in a 4-0 win three weeks later.

Northern Cambria was the only other team to beat the Vikings this season - 5-0 April 26 - and in the first round of the District 6 Class AA playoffs Friday, Glendale settled that score.

The Vikings rapped out 14 hits and got a solid effort on the mound from Brett Miller in an 11-1 win in six innings at the Glendale High School field. It was the Vikings' first playoff win since 1993 when

they upset Portage 3-2.
"That's quite naround," Glendale manager Tom Janowiak said. "It really feels good to come down here and 10-run rule them after they controlled us like they did up there."

The Vikings (11-2) will host the winner of this afternoon's McCort Ferndale-Bishop game in the second round Monday at 4 p.m.

"They hit the ball a ton," said Northern manager Paul Eckenrode, whose team finished at 7-9. "They hit it where we weren't."

With the score tied at 1-1 in the second, the Vikings took the lead for good when Chuck Oshall ripped a two-out double to plate Mike Harpster, who walked to open the inning.

That lead grew to 6-1 in the third as the Vikings sent 10 batters to the plate and

smacked five hits.

Jason Wagner walked and Paul McClellan was hit by a pitch to open the inning and end right-hander Mike right-hander Sherry's day on the mound.

"Sherry only gave up four hits against them in the last game," Eckenrode said. "To-day he didn't give up a lot of

hits, but he gave up a lot of walks. It's very uncharacteristic of Mike to give up walks. I think he was a little nervous.

Miller greeted reliever Ben Westrick with triple down the line to score right field Wagner and McClellan. Mark Smyers then drove Miller in with a single into left-center.

Following a strikeout, Justin Holtz and Jason Turner singled to load the bases for the top of the order. Holtz scored on Josh Irvine's infield single two batters later.

Glendale put the game away in the top of the sixth by batting around and scoring five times against the Colts' third pitcher of the game, Jody Zer-

Zernick had shut the Vikings' bats down in the fourth and the fifth, striking out four and allowing one hit, before Glendale got the bats going

With one out, Wagner lined the second pitch he saw from Zernick over the left-center field fence for his third homer of the season.

McClellan followed with a

double over right fielder Matt Orosz' head and Miller lined a off shortstop single Zanella's glove.

Smyers brought McClellan around with a single to left before Harpster unloaded on Zernick's 1-0 offering and drilled it over the left-center field fence for a three-run home run, his third long ball of the season.

"Mike's a real success story," Janowiak said. "He wasn't a starter last year and he's won himself a spot, he's batting over .400 and he's hit three home runs. He's a perfect example of what our team's been able to do this

Zernick got out of the jam by sandwiching a fly out and a ground out around Turner's single to short right-center.

"You get a good hitting

team like this, and they're going to jump on you after getting a look at a pitcher one time through the lineup," Eckenrode said.

Miller fanned Duane Cover and Bob Sposito to open the bottom of the sixth before pinch hitter Lenny Rogel lifted a ball down the left field line that dropped in between Ir-vine, McClellan and Oshall, Irvine retrieved the ball and threw it to second to nail Rogel and end the game.

"There were too many guys there to catch it," Janowiak said with a laugh. "It was a nice fake because we got the

guy at second."

Miller, who was the winning pitcher in the Vikings' Moshannon Valley League clinching win over Curwensville May 7, limited the Colts to four hits, four walks and one hit batsman in running his record to 6-1 on the season.

"That's his second straight excellent outing," Janowiak said. "He's strong, his control is good, and it's paying off for us. Brett's a pretty accom-plished pitcher right now. Anybody can have a bad day, but he's had two good ones in two important games."
