Walk-off homer gives Vikes a thrilling 9-8 win

FLINTON — Talk about saving your best for last.

With two outs in the bottom of the seventh inning and trailing 8-6, Glendale junior Scott Laing belted a three-run walk-off homerun to lead the Vikings to a come-from-behind 9-8 victory over Harmony on Thursday afternoon.

The blast also gave Laing his first win of the season on the mound. After a shaky first inning in which he surrendered five runs, Laing settled down and allowed just three runs on five hits over the last six innings.

The Glendale rally came after Harmony scored two runs off Laing in the top of the seventh to grab an 8-6 advantage.

"He did a good job as far as keeping a positive attitude," Glendale head coach Rick Kozak said of Laing. "He gave up the five runs in the first inning, but he came back

and he pitched a great game. That last inning, he could have easily given up, but he didn't. He kept his head in there. And then he took one for a ride."

Harmony jumped out to the 5-0 lead in the first inning on the strength of five hits, as well as two Glendale errors.

Josh Hagens, Sam Rorabaugh, Bob Homerski, Chas Gee and Brandon Pearce all hit safely in the inning. Homerski had the big blow in the inning, a two-run single that plated Hagens and Rorabaugh, who had doubled.

Glendale fought back to take the lead in the third inning, scoring six runs of its own.

The Vikings had five hits in the inning, while Harmony committed four costly errors. Derrick Strong, Jeff Parks, Caleb Cherish, Zac Budzinski and Tyler Noel each had singles as Glendale sent 10 batters to the plate.

The Owls tied the game at six in the top

of the fifth inning when Derek Rorabaugh singled home Homerski, who had walked and stole second. Homerski led the Owls' offense, reaching base three times on a hit and two walks, while scoring three runs and driving in two.

That set the stage for the decisive seventh frame.

Homerski started the inning with a walk. He later stole second and moved to third on a wild pitch. Laing struck out the next two Harmony batters, as he looked to get out of the inning unscathed.

But Gee had other ideas, as he laced a single to centerfield to score Homerski, giving the Owls a 7-6 lead.

Gee then stole second and scored on a Pearce base hit. Pearce had three hits in the game, including a double.

Laing got out of the inning when he

induced Jason Romagna to ground out to first base.

After being on the losing end of several games due to errors, Glendale finally got to see the other side of the coin.

Richie Ball and Cherish each reached base on Harmony throwing errors in the home half of the seventh, before Laing stepped to the plate and clubbed his game winning blast off Owl pitcher Larry Spaid.

Spaid worked 6 2/3 innings, and gave up all nine Viking runs, although none of them were earned. He gave up seven hits and a walk, while striking out six.

"It's nice to be on the other end for a change and not have all the errors work against you," Kozak said. "We really did (play good defense) minus that first inning. We got a little careless

there in the seventh, but other than that we did a great job. We definitely made improvements in that area.

"This win is huge for us right now," Kozak continued. "We've been telling the kids since our game against Tyrone that if you hang in there and keep playing good baseball like you're capable of doing, good things will happen for you. Today was proof of that. We played a good ball team. They have a lot of excellent hitters on their team, and they did a good job making contact and making plays. Finally today the ball rolled for us."

With the win, Glendale improved to 2-8 overall and 1-2 in the Moshannon Valley League. Harmony drops to 2-5 overall and 0-4 in the MVL.

The Vikings return to action today, going on the road to play Southern Huntingdon in a Blair County League game. Harmony will host MVL rival Curwensville on Monday.
