Noel Doubt About It

Tyler Noel strikes out 18 batters in Vikes' 7-2 victory over Harmony

WESTOVER — The Glendale baseball team rode the arm of Tyler Noel and the bat of Richie Ball to a 7-2 win over Moshannon Valley League rival Harmony on Thursday in Westover.

Ball got the offense going in the top half of the first inning off of Owl pitcher Dustin Neff.

With one out, the Vikings got back-to-back singles from Derrick Strong and Bob Hewitt, before Ball took Neff deep to left for a three-run homer giving his team the early advantage.

Glendale wasn't finished there, as Noel drew a walk and gave way to courtesy runner Derek Nash, who then stole second, before scoring on a single from Viking catcher Gary Walstrom to push the lead to 4-0.

Neff got himself out of the jam by recording a pair of strikeouts to end the threat.

Harmony threatened in the bottom half of the first, as a two-out walk from Sean Fox and a single from Dustin Neff put the

Owls in a position to make up some ground.

Grant Neff, Fox's courtesy runner, drew a throw from the outfield as he advanced to third on the Dustin Neff's single, which also let the Harmony senior take second.

But Noel refused to let any significant damage be done as he struck out Brandon Pearce to end the inning.

"He definitely had it going," Glendale head coach Rick Kozak said. "They weren't really able to get around on his fastball today. He did a nice job."

Glendale added to its lead in the top of the second.

Senior Alan Collins drew a walk to open the frame, and leadoff hitter Kelsey Tarr reached on an error to put runners on first and second.

Strong came through with his second single in as many innings to plate Collins and advance Tarr to third.

Neff had Strong leaning towards second, but his pickoff throw went over first baseman

Chas Gee's head, enabling Tarr to score and moving Strong from first to third.

Hewitt followed Strong with his second single of the ballgame to push the Viking lead to 7-0.

The Vikings had another runner reach second, but Neff got out of the inning with another strikeout.

"Dustin pitched a good game," said Harmony coach Scott Fye. "He's worked real hard to get where he is now. We just started out a little slow and it cost us."

Harmony got on the board in the bottom half of the inning, as Cory White legged out an infield single to start the frame.

After Noel recorded a strikeout, Owl center fielder Caleb Rorabaugh connected on one of his three hits of the afternoon to push White up 90 feet.

Owl freshman Daren Peace drew a walk to load the bases, and Gee followed it up with a bloop single to plate White.

That was the only damage that Harmony could muster, as Noel stopped the bleeding and recorded two more strikeouts to the end Owls' hopes for a big inning.

"It's good (the performance) because I know we can get it done," Fye said. "We can get runners in scoring position. It (winning) can happen, they just need a little more confidence in themselves."

After the second inning, both hurlers settled in and were in command for the rest of the afternoon.

Noel recorded 18 strikeouts on the day, while Neff also reached double-digits, striking out 13.

The Glendale senior only allowed three Harmony players to reach base from the end of the second until the top of the seventh, but any hope of the Owls scoring more runs were extinguished, as Noel picked off Rorabaugh at first, and Walstrom threw out Gee trying to steal second.

Neff was equally as impressive, as the Owl lefty retired 14 of the last 18 batters that he faced, and also picked a runner off of first base.

"He (Neff) pitched a heck of a game," said Kozak. "All we had was one inning and he shut us down."

The Vikings threatened in the top half of the seventh as they placed runners on first and second with just one out. But Neff showed his mettle as he induced Noel to fly out to center and struck out Walstrom to end the threat.

Harmony showed it wasn't going away with out a battle.

Rorabaugh led off the inning with a double and later scored on a passed ball to cut the Glendale lead to 7-2.

Gee got things going for the Owls by drawing a walk, then moved to second on a dropped fly ball that could have ended the game.

Noel then walked Neff to load the bases, before striking out Pearce to end the game.

Harmony left the bases loaded twice and had two other runners in scoring position that were left stranded.

"We're young," Fye said, "but its going to come. I feel good about the season, I feel good about the kids. They're willing to take criticism and come back the next day to work on it."

Glendale upped its overall and MVL record to 1-0 on the season. Harmony fell to 0-2 overall and 0-2 in the MVL.

"The kids did a good job," said Kozak, "and, for the most part, we were pretty solid defensively."

Both teams return to action today, as the Vikes host Bishop Guilfoyle and the Owls travel to Purchase Line.
