Ivory got the last laugh, how-ever, as he lifted Glendale to a come-from-behind win by belting a two-run walkoff home run for a

7-6 victory.

Ivory also earned his first win of the season in relief of starter Brad O'Donnell. O'Donnell went into the sixth before the Warriors finally took the lead, but Ivory came in and ended the inning with consecutive ground-

Todd Rees connected on a two-out double in the seventh for West Branch, but Ivory bounced back with his only strikeout to keep it a one-run deficit heading into the bottom half of the

"It was a nice hit ... he was due," said Glendale coach Mark Queen of Ivory's home run. "He's been struggling, everyone's been struggling with our bats. He was just due. It was just meeting the ball. We keep telling them just to meet it. That's all we've got to do.

"He pitches pretty well most of the time. There are a few times where he gets out of control, but he's done well this year. The main thing is he's only a junior and he's coming back,

which will be nice."

For West Branch, the loss ended its season on a sour note just one day after it clinched the Moshannon Valley League title with a dominating performance over Curwensville.

The Warriors, who went scoreless through the first four innings with six runners in scoring position, trailed Glendale 4-0 heading into the fifth where they pushed anything across against O'Donnell.

West Branch ended its cam-

paign with a 10-9 mark.
"I told them the way it was we played a three-inning game and watched them play the first four," Warriors coach Jake Myers said. "You don't win many games playing three innings, but they play us tough all the time. I don't care what their record is ... we have a tough battle every time we play them.

"We did some good things in the last three innings of the game," said Myers. "If we played the whole game like that, I think we could have pulled this out. We had such a big win yesterday and we were so high, but it's really tough to come and play the next day. I wish we could've had a day off."

Glendale cut West Branch's lead in half in the bottom of the inning, as Dustin Shaffer connected on a solo homer to set the stage for Ivory's heroics.

After having a perfect game thrown at them on Monday, the Vikings bounced back with a 10hit effort, including three from O'Donnell and two from Vance
