## Glendale rallies to top Mo Valley at Blair County Ballpark

ALTOONA — The Glendale baseball team has struggled to crack the win column this season under first-year head coach Dan Sanders.

After coming up short in his first six contests, Sanders and his Vikings got their first 'W' of the season — and couldn't have picked a better day or venue to do it.

Glendale picked up some timely hits and rode the relief of Michael Wigfield on the mound in a 6-4 win at the Blair County Ballpark on Saturday over rival Moshannon Valley.

"(Playing here) and playing against our rivals made it real nice," said Sanders of the win. "They played well even after we got down four runs there in the third. We played really well.

"We toughed it out, made some plays and got some good pitching."

The Vikings trailed the Black Knights 4-2 heading into the bottom of the sixth, where they utilized their aggression on the basepaths.

Timmy Sutton smacked a key 2-run single to knot the score,

and took third base when the outfield put runners on second and third with no one out.

Sanders gambled and let Jarid Ivory break for home on a 1-ball, 2-strike offering to Patrick Hamilton.

Hamilton put the ball in play and was gunned down at first, but Ivory and Sutton, who was also off on the pitch, scored on the play.

"It almost got us in trouble before that," Sanders said of his team's aggression, which led to three caught-stealings. "(Ivory) waited it out and made a good break on it.

"I've been coaching these guys since Little League, and I've always been really aggressive with them (on the bases) — especially with the hit and run on there."

The 2-run cushion was more than enough for Wigfield, who retired the first eight hitters he faced and 10 of 11 in all.

The lone blemish against the Viking reliever was a one-out

single in the seventh. Wigfield got out of any potential danger with a pop up and his fifth strikeout to end it.

"The first guy was coming over the top at us, and when Wigfield came in he kind of went with a three-quarter look," said Mo Valley head coach Justin Fye. "I don't know if they just weren't picking the ball up off of him or what was going on.

"Last year he came in and did a real good job against us, too. It didn't seem like he was throwing many curveballs or changeups. We pulled our head a lot today, but he did a great job coming in there."

A third-inning error led to three unearned runs against Glendale starter Justin Kephart, who fell further behind the Black Knights after RBI singles from Bobby Gallagher and Luther Harlow.

Like the first two innings, Kephart worked out of the jam. The Glendale sophomore saw Zack Jasper lead off the game with a triple and issued a walk to No. 2 hitter Cody Harsomchuck, who stole second.

With his back against the

wall with runners in scoring position and nobody out, Kephart fanned Mo Valley's Nos. 3, 4, and 5 hitters to escape unscathed.

Kephart finished the game with six strikeouts in 3 2/3 innings.

"Him pitching out of that was as big as us scoring the runs," Sanders said. "He kept it to four runs and let us in the game. It was a good effort by both pitchers. They hung in there real well."

The Knights struggled to find the timely hitting to push runs across the plate, as they left seven runners on base in the contest — four of which were in scoring position. Mo Valley also had a player picked off third base.

"We left a lot of guys on base," said Fye. "The games we lost earlier we were leaving a lot of guys on base. Their pitchers threw lots of strikes and did a good job (getting out of jams), but we didn't have good at-bats. It just looked like we came out

and weren't seeing the ball very well today.

"Momentum is a big thing in baseball. Even in the fourth when they scored some runs, we couldn't stop their momentum. They just kept it rolling."

Gallagher allowed a solid single to Mitchell Gedman in the first, but kept the Vikings handcuffed for the better part of his 5 1/3 innings of work.

The Knight hurler struck out nine and allowed seven hits, many of which found open spots in the shallow outfield.

"It's not always how hard you hit it, but where you hit it," Sanders said. "We had some good at-bats. You have to take whatever you can get against (Gallagher). He was sharp. I was surprised we got to him and got some floaters that we did.

"They have a good ball team. They're as good as any team we've seen. We just finally got a couple of breaks to go our way."

Gedman finished the game 3-for-3, while Sutton was 2-for-3 with three RBIs. Gallagher had three of his team's five hits.

Both teams are back in action today. The Vikings (1-6) travel to Curwensville, while the

Knights (2-3) take to the road to face Bellwood-Antis.
