

Glendale baseball optimistic about 2013

FLINTON — Although there is little experience and just two letterwinners returning for the Glendale baseball team, there is still much to be optimistic for in the 2013 season.

Dan Sanders, who was the head coach for two seasons for the Vikings, stepped down in the offseason after a 6-12 season a year ago and handed over the reins to Joe Klezek.

Klezek, who is a Central Cambria graduate and played collegiate baseball at Penn State Beaver and Clarion University, inherits a program that graduated eight seniors last year.

"It's been pretty difficult with the weather not cooperating," said Klezek. "We're trying to stay out of a sense of boredom with being in the gym the whole time. You can only do the same drill so many times, but it is what it is."

"They'd rather be outside. We went outside on Wednesday when it was freezing out, but it was still better than being inside. I'm surprisingly upbeat for the way that they've been taking it."

The two letterwinners, Justin Kephart and Tyler Potutschnig, combined for 58 1/3 of the innings pitched for the Vikings last season.

Kephart finished the season with a 2-5 record and a 7.77 ERA and threw one complete game against backyard rival Moshannon Valley. Potutschnig finished with an 0-4 record, but did not give up more than four

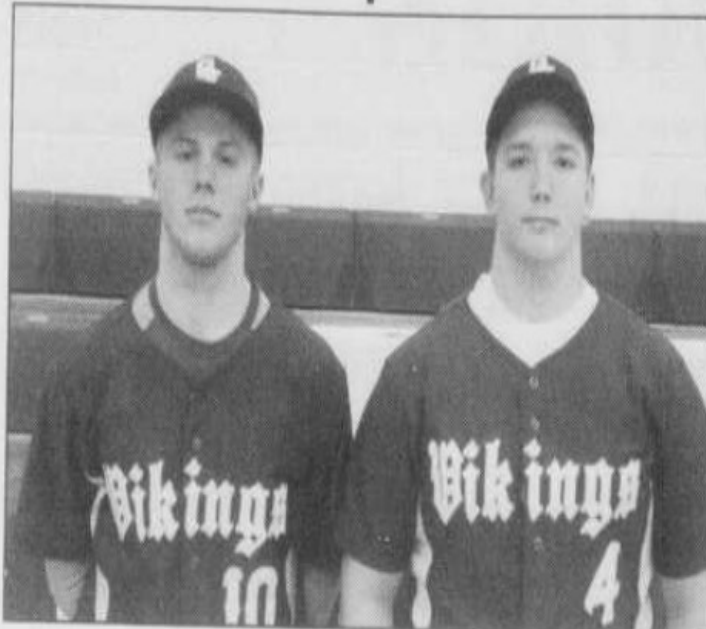

earned runs in any outing.

"It's always good to have your top two pitchers back," said Klezek. "They've been looking pretty decent with mound work in the gym. We're going to go as they go."

"I like what we have with our top two pitchers. Having that stability is definitely a good place to start."

Sophomores Craig Hewitt and Alex Iraca each saw limited time on the mound last year and will join Kephart and Potutschnig in the team's starting rotation. Keith Gates and Taylor Jersey will also provide some relief work for the Vikings.

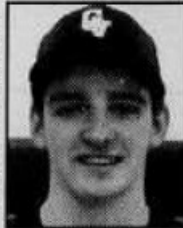
